6 WHEREAS, participants from Japan will be making their 3<sup>rd</sup> visit to Agana 7 Heights Elementary School this year and their 10<sup>th</sup> overall visit to Guam. Participants 8 from Guam have also traveled to Japan with Agana Heights Elementary School 9 sending a 5 member delegation to Japan last summer as part of this program; and
