1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***
3 **WHEREAS, Senior Master Sergeant Ruben A. Dalalo was born in Okinawa, Japan.**
4 **He is married to Remy C. Dalalo, and they were blessed with 5 children and 2**
5 **grandsons; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, in June 1978, Sergeant Dalalo graduated from the Guam
2 Vocational Technical High School studying in the field of Accounting; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Dalalo enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in June 1981, and
4 he attended the Air Force basic military training and technical training in October
5 1981. In January 1998, he completed his technical school at Keesler Air Force Base
6 in Mississippi as an Administrative Staff Support Specialist; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Dalalo's first duty assignment was with the 321st
8 Combat Support Group at Grand Forks, North Dakota, where he served as a Staff
9 Support Specialist at the MWR Division. While serving there, he excelled and
10 received several Airman of the Quarter awards, and the IG Professional Performer
11 award; and he was promoted to E-4, Senior Airman, below-the-zone, months ahead of
12 his contemporaries; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Wing Commander took notice of Sergeant Dalalo's potential
14 and tapped him to work at the Wing Executive Branch Office, 321st Strategic Missile
15 Wing, where he quality-controlled all correspondences, messages, awards, and
16 decoration packages; the Airman and Officer appraisals for the Wing Commander;
17 and the Air Division Commander endorsements; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in November 1985, Sergeant Dalalo was hand-picked for an
19 assignment to Andersen Air Force Base, Guam to serve as the Non Commissioned
20 Officer In Charge of Administration, Professional Military Education (PME) Center.
21 He instructed at both the Non Commission Office Preparatory Course (NCOPC), and
22 the Non Commission Office Leadership School; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Commandant of the PME Center later assigned Sergeant
24 Dalalo to serve as the NCOPC Course Manager, where he ran the two-week course
25 single-handedly. He raised the bar by conducting the first NCOPC graduation
26 luncheons, coordinating field trips to the flight simulators and class legacy projects,
27 and providing successful 2 week summer leadership seminars for the JFK High
28 School AF JROTC cadets.

1 **WHEREAS**, in September 1989, Sergeant Dalalo left the active duty service to
2 join the Guam Air National Guard as a traditional Guardsman; and he pursued
3 endeavors in the civilian sector and served at the Guam Memorial Hospital as the
4 Assistant Administrator of Procurement and Supply; and

5 **WHEREAS**, from April 1994 to December 2000, Sergeant Dalalo managed a
6 successful family-owned and operated medical supply business; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Dalalo was assigned to the 254th Civil Engineer
8 Squadron and served in various capacities, to include, Liquid Fuels & Utilities
9 Journeyman, NCOIC of Information Management, and Unit Education & Training
10 Manager; and

11 **WHEREAS**, as a Guardsman, Sergeant Dalalo participated in various territorial
12 call ups for post typhoon recovery efforts; the Korean Airlines 007 crash; Operation
13 Pacific Haven; Desert Shield and Desert Storm; Operations Noble Eagle & Enduring
14 Freedom; and off-island deployments and humanitarian missions in countries such as
15 the Philippines, Korea, Japan and Thailand; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Dalalo effectively managed the Army National Guard
17 Readiness Center training unit, working hand-in-hand with the ANG CE Training
18 Manager; and he was nominated as the Civil Engineer Squadron Senior Non
19 Commissioned Officer of the Year, and was also named as the 1999 Guam ANG
20 Senior Non Commissioned Officer of the Year; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in April 2002, Sergeant Dalalo was selected to take on an Active
22 Guard Reserve (AGR) position as the Base Education and Training Manager for the
23 254 ABG, where he doubled the formal school attendance rate, secured and filled
24 hard-to-get CE craftsman courses, and significantly improved the squadron OJT
25 program and CDC administration. He served in this capacity until he was reassigned
26 to serve as a Budget Analyst in the Finance Section; and


27 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Dalalo is a recipient of several major awards and
28 decorations, including: the Air Force Meritorious Service Medal; the Air Force

1 Commendation Medal; the Air Force Outstanding Unit Award; the Air Force Good
2 Conduct Medal; the Air Reserve Forces Meritorious Service Medal; the National
3 Defense Service Medal; the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; the
4 Humanitarian Service Medal; the Air Force Longevity Service Medal; and the Armed
5 Forces Reserve Medal; now therefore, be it


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
7 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
8 of Guam, commend and congratulate Senior Master Sergeant Ruben A. Dalalo on the

10 active military service; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'*
11 and *Maraming Salamat Po!* to him for his accomplishments, and his leadership and
12 dedication to our island and our country; and be it further
