BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

WHEREAS, Dr. Keith M. Horinouchi, DrPH, MPH, CNS, is the outgoing Chairman of the Guam Diabetes Control Coalition (GDCC). He was responsible for spearheading the steering committee that established the Coalition in December 2008, and he has served as the Coalition's Chairman since then; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Horinouchi's career in public health started in his commitment to education. In 1979, he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology at Loma Linda University, California. After graduation, he continued his education and acquired Master of Public Health (MPH) degrees in Nutrition and Health Education in 1982; and he soon acquired his Doctor of Public Health (DrPH) in Preventive Care in 1982 at Loma Linda University in California; and

WHEREAS, prior to his career in Guam, Dr. Horinouchi gained invaluable experience and knowledge in the previous positions he served in his early career. He practiced in California as the Director of Health Promotion & Preventive Care Specialists at the Riverside-San Bernardino County Indian Health, Inc., from 1983 to 1986. He then moved to Hawaii in 1986 and served as Clinic Administrator at Waikele Dispensary; Hospital Administrator (CEO) at the Kauai Veterans' Memorial Hospital; Assistant Hospital Administrator (COO) at the Kina Community Hospital; and Preventive Care Specialist and Director at WellCare Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, in 1996, Dr. Horinouchi became the Director of the Seventh Day Adventist (SDA) Wellness Center and served as a Clinical Preventionist & Nutrition Specialist until 2011, where he utilized lifestyle and nutritional medicine for the management and prevention of chronic lifestyle diseases and aging. At the same time in 2008, he served as the project co-director for the Guam *Sustanasa* Project, where *Ypao* SDA Church received a grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation for the control of childhood obesity until its completion in 2010. In 2012, Dr. Horinouchi opened his Wellness Clinic, which provides the community with lifestyle and nutritional medicine approaches to chronic diseases and health concerns, including diabetes, digestion problems, fatigue, hormone imbalances, hypertension, obesity, cancer, heart disease and cognitive/behavioral problems; and

WHEREAS, aside from his professional career, Dr. Horinouchi serves as an advocate for a better lifestyle and better health for the community. He served as the Chairman of the Guam Diabetes Control Coalition (GDCC) from 2008 to 2013. Under his leadership, the GDCC completed the Diabetes Asset Mapping for Guam; the Diabetes Collaborative Messages for Physical Activity, Nutrition, Foot Care, and Tobacco Prevention; the Diabetes Directory; and the Guam Diabetes Needs Assessment. In addition, Dr. Horinouchi contributed to the efforts of the first Guam Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance (BRFSS) Annual Report for 2007 to 2010, as well as contributing to the development of the Non-Communicable Disease (NCD) Plan for Guam; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Horinouchi is a member of the NCD Consortium, Nutrition Action Group, to implement the NCD Plan to establish community gardens throughout the island to promote the consumption of fruits and vegetables. In 2010, he developed the "Health Curriculum for Health Coaches" for the Worksite Wellness Program under the Communities Putting Prevention to Work (CPPW) of the American Recovery Reinvestment Act (ARRA) initiative; and he trained 23 health coaches from 23 government agencies, who have successfully implemented the program. He also provided technical assistance, consultation and screening for health coaches and employees under the Worksite Wellness Program for government agencies, private partners, non-governmental organizations, and faith-based communities; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Horinouchi expanded his skills to maximize his contribution to the community. In 2010, he assisted in the drafting of legislation that mandated healthy foods to be sold in vending machines at all government of Guam buildings, which later became Public Law 31-141. He also contributed to the efforts of the Secretariat of the Pacific (SPC) and World Health Organization (WHO) Food Security Workshop. Dr. Horinouchi also represented the Guam NCD Community and provided Guam success stories at the SPC-WHO 2-1-22 meeting in Tonga in 2011, and at the Pacific Summit on Diabetes in Saipan in 2008; and

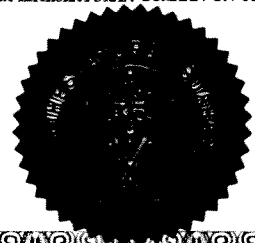




