
WHEREAS, Mary and Art Casper's love of Guam and their family ties on the island have enabled them to make many friends who share their interest in Guam. One such friend was RADM Joseph Ekelund, USN RET, former Superintendent of the Naval Post Graduate School (NPS) in Monterey, California. RADM Ekelund and his wife, Lynn, belong to the same Catholic Chapel community at St. Thomas Aquinas at NPS where the Caspers also attend Mass. When they heard about Mary being from Guam and of the plans for the Casper family to return to the island in March 2013 for a family visit, they gave Art and Mary a photo album containing pictures taken on Guam from 1933 to 1936. They thought they would enjoy these photos of the then Naval Governor of Guam, Captain Alexander, taken by his Executive Officer, CDR Linsley. 

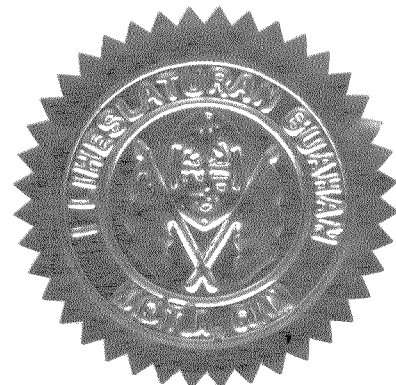
