4        the village of *Toto*; and she is the daughter of Julianna and Ramon Quidachay; and

5        **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Guerrero graduated from George Washington High School.  
6        She attended the University of Guam for two semesters and studied Criminal Justice

1 Courses, and she then went on to study Procurement Law at the Guam Community  
2 College; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Guerrero is the widow of Edward Guerrero, and they have  
4 three children: Jessica, Susan and May. She is blessed with two sons-in-law, Vince  
5 and Augusto; and three grandchildren, Steven Jr., Seleen, and Vaeden Matthew; and

6 **WHEREAS**, on August 29, 1983, Mrs. Guerrero started her government of  
7 Guam career at the Judiciary of Guam, serving as a Secretary; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Guerrero was reclassified to an Administrative Secretary I  
9 on October 1, 1985; and on October 1, 1987, she was reclassified to an Administrative  
10 Secretary II; and

11 **WHEREAS**, on August 5, 1991, Rita's position title was changed to Court  
12 Fiscal Officer I; and on September 30, 1994, Mrs. Guerrero was promoted to Court  
13 Fiscal Officer II; and

14 **WHEREAS**, because of her exemplary work ethic, and dedication to helping  
15 the island community, Mrs. Guerrero was a recipient of a number of commendations  
16 and letters of appreciation, including, a Letter of Appreciation from Deputy  
17 Administrative Director Perry C. Taitano on October 21, 1983; a Letter of  
18 Appreciation from Administrative Director of the Courts, Robert E. Leon Guerrero on  
19 April 9, 1986; a Certificate of Recognition from the Bureau of Women's Affairs on
