3 with the Bureau and held various positions, including as a Social Worker III, and she  
4 was finally promoted to the position of Social Service Supervisor I with the Child  
5 Protective Services Intake/Crisis Unit, where she served until her retirement; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Bobbie has dedicated 25 years of her life to her career in helping  
7 children and their families during times of crisis. For many years, she had the  
8 responsibility of ensuring that the thousands of child abuse and neglect referrals  
9 received annually by the Bureau were processed, and that crisis referrals were  
10 immediately assessed to ensure the safety of children at high risk. She was also  
11 involved with the Healing Hearts Steering Committee, and she was a Field Instructor  
12 for Social Work and Psychology student interns; and

13           **WHEREAS**, throughout Bobbie's years of service, funding constraints in the  
14 government had provided many challenges for the Bureau, to include the lack of  
15 adequate staffing, resulting in the system being stretched beyond capacity. In the face  
16 of all of this, Bobbie had worked in the evenings, and on weekends and holidays, and  
17 she has always remained unwavering and dedicated to her work. Because of her  
18 commitment and passion for her work, children and their families are now in a better  
19 place; and

20           **WHEREAS**, Bobbie will always be fondly remembered by her colleagues for  
21 her good-natured spirit, her friendliness, and her smile. She is rarely ever seen getting  
22 upset, despite the daily stresses that are known in the child protection environment.  
23 On the contrary, Bobbie has always kept her composure and is jokingly known as the  
24 Bureau's "diva," as she is often seen touching up her makeup and usually arrives at  
25 work every Monday with a new hair style or color; and
