1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***
3 **WHEREAS**, the University of Phoenix is an accredited institution of higher
4 learning with campuses located nationwide in the United States, and in many
5 countries, with a diverse on-line education program and an enrollment of
6 approximately 300,000 students; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the University of Phoenix Asia Military Campus operations
2 established its first classes on Guam ten years ago, in July 2003, bringing higher
3 education to all; and

4 **WHEREAS**, during this period, the University of Phoenix has expanded its
5 degree and on-line course offerings covering Associate, Bachelor, Graduate, and
6 Doctoral levels of education, to include a Master's of Business Administration degree
7 offered to the military community on Guam by the Asia Military Campus at the
8 Andersen Learning Center; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the number of local graduates has grown each year over the past
10 ten years, and in 2013, the number of graduates will have reached 200. While
11 onground programs focus exclusively on management and business education, the on-
12 line offerings have provided degree programs in a diverse set of fields, to include
13 degrees in the fields of elementary education, psychology, nursing, health care
14 administration, human resources management, criminal justice administration, and
15 information technology; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the University of Phoenix has trained many local managers, and
17 its Guam graduates include Dr. Mary Okada, Dr. Bert Johnston, Flora Baza Quan
18 MBA, Janalyn Rosario MBA, and John Dennett MBA; and Michael Ada MBA and Dr.
19 Rita Sablan of the CNMI, and with over 100 graduates in business and management
20 working for local businesses, who are helping to grow Guam's economy; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the University of Phoenix on-line format for most of its course
22 offerings allows our local adult workforce to improve their education with high
23 quality instruction and personal learning, without attendance in traditional classes; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the University of Phoenix traditional classes are taught by local
25 part-time faculty, including Dr. Carmen Fernandez, Dr. Bert Johnston, Dr. Cyd Naid-
26 Coloma, Janalyn Rosario MBA, Amber San Gil MBA, Elizabeth Cena CPA, John
27 Dennett MBA, Timothy Moon MBA, and Attorney Robert Cruz; now therefore, be it

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
3 of Guam, recognize the University of Phoenix Asia Pacific Program on its 10th Year

6 through the University of Phoenix programs, and wish them well in their future
