**Relative to recognizing and commending Gayle R. Osborn for
being the Founder of *Youth for Youth LIVE! Guam.***

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Gayle R. Osborn was born on December 3, 1954; and graduated
4 from George Washington High School in 1972; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn started working with the Department of Mental
6 Health and Substance Abuse in 1982, serving as a Project Coordinator with the
7 Prevention and Training Branch; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Osborn is a Certified Prevention Specialist with the
9 International Certification & Reciprocity Consortium (IC&RC); and

1 **WHEREAS**, in May 1988, Ms. Osborn was instrumental in starting the Dededo
2 Drug Free Organization, also known as DDFO, a drug prevention community-based
3 organization; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in July 1988, Ms. Osborn took the first group of six members to
5 the Western States Youth to Youth Conference in Claremont, California; and

6 **WHEREAS**, from 1988 to 1989, Ms. Osborn and the Dededo Drug Free
7 Organization (DDFO) brought the Red Ribbon Campaign to Guam in all the schools;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, in May 1990, Ms. Osborn assisted the officers in organizing the
10 1st Annual Dededo Drug Free Organization (DDFO) Conference on Guam, and “If It
11 Is Up To Me...Drug-Free!” was its theme. Approximately 300 youth from almost
12 every middle and high school on Guam participated; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in March 1991, Ms. Osborn was instrumental in having the
14 Dededo Drug Free Organization (DDFO) receive the Guam Association of Social
15 Workers (GASW) Community Service Organization Award; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in 1991, Gayle assisted the DDFO Officers once again in writing
17 a grant for approximately \$89,000; and she was successful in taking approximately 69
18 youth and a chaperone from almost every middle and high school on Guam, both
19 public and private, to the Western States Youth to Youth Conference in Claremont,
20 California; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in May 1992, the 2nd Annual DDFO Conference was held, and
22 continued every year thereafter. Approximately 350 to 400 youth from almost every
23 middle and high school on Guam participated, as well as participants from the CNMI,
24 Palau, FSM and RMI; and

25 **WHEREAS**, in 1996, there was the beginning of more partnerships with the
26 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse and the Guam Chamber of
27 Commerce, in starting the Youth Summer and Water Safety Programs; and

1 **WHEREAS**, also in 1996, Ms. Osborn was nominated by the Mayor of
2 *Dededo*, and was awarded the “Woman of the Year Award” for the village of *Dededo*;
3 and


4 **WHEREAS**, in 1998, DDFO officially became the Youth for Youth
5 Organization, which endeavored for ten years in the making of youth helping youth
6 throughout the island of Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 2008, the name was changed to *Youth for Youth LIVE! Guam*
8 and in 2010, Ms. Osborn was the Adult Chairperson for the 20th Youth for Youth
9 Conference, with its theme of “HYPE: Helping Young People Empower!”; now
10 therefore, be it


11 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
