3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Anthony A. Meno was born on March 28, 1960; and is the
4 son of Prudencio C. and Cresencia A. Meno. He was raised in the village of *Merizo*,
5 along with his seven siblings; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1982, Mr. Meno graduated from the University of Guam with a
2 Bachelor’s Degree in Accounting; and in 1989, he also earned a Master’s Degree in
3 Public Administration from the University of Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Meno is married to Lavonne C. Meno, and they have 2
5 daughters, Camarin and Athena; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Meno is an active participant in various outreach activities
7 within the community, and he has served as the Treasurer of his Parish Council at
8 Our Lady of Purification Catholic Church in *Maina*, from 2008 to 2011; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Meno began his career with the Government of Guam on
10 April 19, 1982, serving as an Accountant I with the University of Guam; and he
11 remained in that position until July 15, 1984; and

12 **WHEREAS**, on July 16, 1984, Mr. Meno was promoted to an Accountant II at
13 the University of Guam; and he remained in that position until March 19, 1993; and

14 **WHEREAS**, on April 5, 1993, Mr. Meno then began his career with the
15 Judiciary of Guam, serving as the Controller; and

16 **WHEREAS**, because of his exemplary work ethic, his dedication, and his help
17 to the island community, Mr. Meno was recognized and nominated for the
18 J.U.S.T.I.C.E. Award, “Medal of Valor (Medal of Honor)”, for FY 2006 and 2007,
19 which is only awarded to Judiciary of Guam Employees who perform official tasks
20 with great dedication and compassion, displaying courage and bravery beyond the call
21 of duty; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Meno had attended numerous training programs, which
2 include, but are not limited to: a Performance Measurement and Budgeting Course;
3 the Supervision and Leadership Training; Ethics and Customer Service in the Courts;
4 Professional Ethics; Government Auditing; the AICPA Accounting Standards
5 Training, and Transparency in the Public Sector; the Governmental Accounting
6 Standards Board Updates; and the Service Efforts and Accomplishments (SEA)
7 Performance Reporting; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Meno became a member of the Association of Government
9 Accountants, from February of 1993 until the present; and he is also a Certified
10 Government Financial Manager as of November 1996; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Meno had held his position as the Judiciary of Guam
12 Controller until he retired on March 22, 2013; now therefore, be it

19 to the people of Guam, and wish him well in his future endeavors; and be it further


20 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
