7 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association (GMHVA)
8 is recognizing Ms. Esther K. Jung with the “GMHVA Lifetime Member” award.
9 Throughout her involvement with the Association, she has expressed her sincere
10 efforts in assisting with the healthcare needs of our island community; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 1993, Ms. Esther K. Jung started working as a member of the
12 Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association (GMHVA). Her service has been
13 significant to the Association and her work continues to be greatly appreciated by her
14 colleagues; and

16 where she is responsible for pricing and operations, as well as assisting in the annual
17 inventory. She also captures and maintains baby photos of newborn babies at the
18 Hospital; and

19 **WHEREAS**, since her involvement with the GMHVA, Esther has participated
20 in numerous activities that provided service to the community. She also contributes
21 through donations to raise funds that will benefit charities and activities involving the
22 community. These efforts include serving food at the Friary during Christmas season,
23 as well as celebrating Three Kings Day in the Skilled Nursing Unit; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Esther values her spiritual life, and she continues to extend her
25 prayers to the patients and volunteers at GMH.; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the GMH Volunteers Association conducts activities that are
2 meant to assist with the needs of the hospital and the community, and Esther also
3 participates in those efforts, such as the Annual Charity Ball and the Thanksgiving
4 raffle event to benefit the various areas of need at the Hospital; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the GMHVA is growing in membership and Esther assists in this

8 participate in committee meetings because she could not understand English, but

12 incoming Korean patients that enables the staff and the doctors to better cater to their
13 needs. Her involvement in this area is significant, for which the medical staff is
14 grateful; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Esther has been an instrumental member of the Guam Memorial
16 Hospital Volunteers Association, and the GMH Volunteer Association has been
17 significant in assisting with the healthcare needs of our island community; now
18 therefore, be it

4 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


