3 **WHEREAS,** the Lodging Management Program (LMP) is a national
4 education program for high school students that covers topics in the Program,
5 including, but not limited to, lodging management, rooms division operations,

1 leadership skills, career planning, food and beverage skills, sales and marketing,
2 and event planning; and

3 **WHEREAS**, an annual LMP competition is sponsored by the American
4 Hotel and Lodging’s Educational Institute that is meant to provide a venue to
5 demonstrate, challenge, and expose students to the functions of the hotel industry;

7 **WHEREAS**, in 2001, the Guam Community College established the
8 Lodging Management Program, and has established programs at each of Guam’s
9 public high schools, hosting its own local competition to determine the Guam
10 representative to the International LMP Competition held annually in Orlando
11 Florida; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the International Lodging Management Program Competition
13 was held on April 10 to April 12, 2013, at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in
14 Orlando, Florida; and the Guam representative for 2013 was the team from *Okkodo*
15 High School, under the tutelage of Instructor Evon Wong, and comprised of
16 members: Flori Ann Dela Cruz – Team Captain, Rainalou Sison, Christian Lubas,
17 and Royalle Mae Carter; and


18 **WHEREAS**, in all, thirteen state teams competed and the *Okkodo* High
19 School team from Guam placed 2nd for the second year in a row at the International

26 Management Program Competition; and does further commend and extend


1 congratulations to the team and its instructor for their continued academic
