- WHEREAS, Mrs. Felicidad Almonte Castillo, known to her family and
- 4 friends as "Fely," was born on October 12, 1912, in the small town of Mangaldan
- 5 in the province of Pangasinan, Philippines. She is the eldest child of three children
- 6 born to Aurelia Astacio and Bernadino Almonte; and

1	WHEREAS, in 1934, Fely married Mr. Espiritu P. "Pedro" Castillo, a
2	fisherman in her village, where together they relied on the sea to support
3	themselves and their family; and
4	WHEREAS, while her husband fished, Fely enjoyed helping to sell the fish
5	in the village, and she was able to successfully sell their fish because of her
6	friendly personality; and
7	WHEREAS, after many years of fishing in their home village, the fish
8	market declined dramatically due to extensive dynamiting around the area. Fely
9	and her husband were forced to buy and sell fish in the surrounding villages, and
10	were still able to sustain their five children; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Castillo moved to Guam in 1987, and they lived
12	with their son, Ricardo A. Castillo, in the village of Yigo; and
13	WHEREAS, Fely and her husband became active members of the senior
14	citizens community of Guam and frequented the Yigo Senior Citizens Center,
15	where they learned to dance, sing and exercise for fun; and
16	WHEREAS, Mrs. Castillo would often share her stories with her family of
17	her active life at the Yigo Senior Citizens Center and the many outings they
18	enjoyed, such as luncheons at local hotels; and
19	WHEREAS, Fely was an avid attendee of the Senior Center until she
20	experienced a fall that left her with a fractured hip. Fely spent some time at the
21	Guam Memorial Hospital Skilled Nursing Unit, and then recuperated comfortably
22	at home, where nurses and friends from the Senior Center came to visit her several
23	times a week; and
24	WHEREAS, Mrs. Castillo enjoyed eating mangos and bitter melon as her
25	favorite fresh produce to keep her healthy, and she also enjoyed playing card
26	games and bingo to keep her busy; and

1	WHEREAS, Fely and her husband were blessed with their greatest
2	treasure, their family of 17 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren. Fely was
3	called to our Heavenly Father on February 9, 2013, after a long battle with cancer;
4	now therefore, be it
