**Relative to recognizing and honoring Ms. Preciosa Reyes Ulloa as she celebrates her 103<sup>rd</sup> year of life; and to further commending her as a “2013 Senior Citizens Month Centenerian.”**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI DOS LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Preciosa Reyes Ulloa was born on October 24, 1910, in the  
4 village of *Talofof*; and she is the daughter of †Maria Delos Reyes and †Vicente  
5 Ulloa; and

6           **WHEREAS**, being the eldest child of six children, Preciosa had many  
7 responsibilities growing up and she naturally fell into the role as a caregiver, as

1 well as being seen as a mother figure because she worked tirelessly to ensure that  
2 everyone in her family was fine by attending to their individual needs; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Preciosa married Felix Taitague, and they had two children  
4 together: †Josefa and David; and

5 **WHEREAS**, after the passing of her first husband at an early age, Preciosa  
6 married Mr. Vicente Castro in 1945, and together they had five children: Joseph,  
7 †Frank, †Pedro, Arthur and Maria; and

8 **WHEREAS**, as a mother, Preciosa loved and provided for the physical and  
9 emotional needs of her children. Even as her children became adults, Preciosa  
10 always felt obliged to continue loving and caring for them; and

11 **WHEREAS**, despite Preciosa's second marriage ending in a divorce in  
12 1977, she was there to care for her former husband on the weekends when he was  
13 gravely ill with cancer, which demonstrated her caring and forgiving nature; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Preciosa is described as very neat and organized as evidenced  
15 by her choice of work, and she was not one to complain. She took it upon herself  
16 to ensure that things were done properly. She worked hard and took pride in the  
17 quality of the work that she produced. She had worked as a housekeeper for the  
18 late Governor Carlos G. Camacho; and then later, for his brother, Luis Camacho,  
19 who lived in Windward Hills; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in 1994, while at work, Preciosa experienced a stroke and she  
21 fell and injured her head. As a result of the stroke, Preciosa's independence was  
22 affected in the healing process; and

23 **WHEREAS**, at that time, Preciosa's medical doctor predicted that she  
24 possibly had 6 months to live. Given the nature of Preciosa's health, the family  
25 felt that it was in the best interest of Preciosa to receive the required care at Saint  
26 Dominic's Senior Care Home. To this date, almost 19 years later, Preciosa has

1 lived beyond the life expectancy that her doctor had predicted, and her family is  
2 looking forward to celebrating her 103<sup>rd</sup> birthday on October 24, 2013; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Preciosa’s longevity was attributed to her taking good care of  
4 herself, and her daily walks to the *San Miguel Catholic Church* for prayers before  
5 the 7:00 a.m. mass in *Talofofo*; and


6 **WHEREAS**, Preciosa’s devotion to her faith and her dedication to her  
7 family is evident today, as she is blessed with 40 grandchildren, 40 great  
8 grandchildren, 18 great-great grandchildren, and two great-great-great  
9 grandchildren; and

10 **WHEREAS**, people who have known Preciosa would describe her as a very  
11 simple, patient, graceful, devoted, and quiet woman who dedicated her life to her  
12 faith, family and work; now therefore, be it

13 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
14 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and honor Ms. Preciosa Reyes  
15 Ulloa on 103 years of life dedicated to her faith and family, and does commend her  
16 as a “2013 Senior Citizens Month Centenerian”; and be it further

17 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest  
18 to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Ms.  
19 Preciosa Reyes Ulloa; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren*  
20 *Guåhan*.
