2 three granddaughters and a grandson; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. San Agustin started her government career in January 1980,
4 working as a Claims Assistant at the U.S. Department of Defense Finance Office in
5 Vicenza, Italy; and

6 **WHEREAS**, from December 1980 to November 1983, Mrs. San Agustin
7 worked as a Dental Assistant at the U.S. Army Dental Clinic in Vicenza, Italy; and

8 **WHEREAS**, from November 1983 to May 1985, Mrs. San Agustin worked as
9 an Administrative Assistant at the U.S. Army Hospital in Vicenza, Italy; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in July 1985, Mrs. San Agustin then moved to Temple, Texas to
11 work as a Medical Clerk at the U.S. Veterans Affairs Medical Center; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in July 1993, Mrs. San Agustin started working as a Domiciliary
13 Assistant at the Central Texas Veterans Affairs Medical Center; and in December
14 1995, she then began working as a Billing Specialist in Marlin, Texas; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in July 1997, Mrs. San Agustin returned to Temple, Texas, where
16 she worked as a Medical Records Technician at the Central Texas Veterans Affairs
17 Medical Center until July 2000; and

18 *Guåhan*.


