3 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Micronesia Island Fair is the annual signature cultural
4 event of the Guam Visitors Bureau, showcasing the vibrant cultures of Micronesia;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, for the last quarter century, delegations from the Federated
7 States of Micronesia; Rota, Saipan and Tinian; and the Republics of Kiribati, Nauru,
8 the Marshall Islands and Palau have gathered on Guam to commemorate the largest
9 cultural event in the region; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Micronesia Island Fair showcases Micronesia’s
2 master carvers, blacksmiths, traditional fishing experts, jewelers, weavers, dancers,
3 musicians and chefs, and allows visitors to the Fair the chance to experience first-
4 hand the customs that have been passed down and perpetuated through generations;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, twenty-six (26) years ago, on August 26, 1987, the Honorable
7 Joseph F. Ada, Governor of Guam, signed Substitute Bill No. 464 (LS) into law as
8 Public Law No. 19-07, establishing the Guam Micronesia Island Fair; and

9 **WHEREAS**, upon his transmission of Public Law No. 19-07 to *I*
10 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, Governor Ada anticipated “a future of greater cooperation
11 between the people who share the common heritage of this beautiful and bountiful
12 Pacific Ocean”; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the island of Guam is again proud to host our brothers and
14 sisters from across the Pacific Ocean at the Twenty-Sixth (26th) Year Anniversary of
15 the Guam Micronesia Island Fair, “Celebrating Fifty (50) Years of Tourism”, as we
16 continue to strengthen our bonds and move forward in solidarity with our brothers
17 and sisters from across Micronesia and the Pacific through our shared values, our
18 arts and traditions; now therefore, be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’ Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
20 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the organizers and
21 sponsors of the Guam Micronesia Island Fair for their commitment to showcasing

25 Years of Tourism”; and be it further


26 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
