2 **WHEREAS**, the candidates for the 2013 Guam Public School Teacher of the
3 Year are selected on the basis of teaching style; the ability to inspire and engage
4 students; the respect and admiration of students, parents, and colleagues; playing an
5 active and useful role in the community, as well as in the school; and be poised,
6 articulate, and possess the energy to withstand a taxing schedule; and

7 **WHEREAS**, a panel of judges selected Ms. Mary Anne M. Angeles, a Math
8 teacher at Oceanview Middle School, as the 2013 Guam Public School Teacher of the
9 Year from a final list of three outstanding educators; and

10 **WHEREAS**, as a result of her candidacy and selection, it is well known that
11 Ms. Angeles challenges her students of all backgrounds and abilities to learn
12 mathematics, and she encourages them to apply what they are learning since
13 mathematics expresses itself everywhere, in almost every facet of life; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Angeles believes that teachers need to always remember that,
15 aside from parents, teachers are one of the most consistent mentors in a student's life,
16 and that means setting a good example at all times; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Angeles has the teaching ability to take something that may
