3        **WHEREAS, Ms. Alegria A. Quitariano, RN is affectionately known as “Gigi,”**  
4 **and has been working with the Guam Department of Public Health and Social**  
5 **Services since 1986; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitariano attended the University of Santo Tomas in  
2 Manila, Philippines, where she took preparatory courses in Nursing. Later, she  
3 attended Arellano University in Manila, Philippines, where she acquired her Bachelor  
4 of Science degree in Nursing; and

5           **WHEREAS**, from 1976 to 1981, Gigi worked as a Staff Nurse I at the  
6 University of Santo Tomas Hospital in the Labor and Delivery Department. At the  
7 same time, she was also a Nursing Clinical Instructor at the Perpetual Help College of  
8 Nursing in Manila, Philippines; and

9           **WHEREAS**, due to her outstanding work ethic, Gigi was promoted to Head  
10 Nurse in 1981, and she worked at the University of Santo Tomas Hospital until she  
11 moved to Guam; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Gigi then sought employment on the island, and in 1986, she was  
13 successfully employed at the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services,  
14 where she worked as a Nurse Aide at the Bureau of Family Health and Nursing  
15 Services at the Central Region Health Center; and

16           **WHEREAS**, soon thereafter, Gigi was promoted to a Licensed Practical Nurse  
17 I; and two years later, her outstanding work led to her promotion as a Licensed  
18 Practical Nurse II at the same department, and she then transferred to the Northern  
19 Region Health Center; and

20           **WHEREAS**, in 1990, Gigi became a Community Health Nurse I, and in the  
21 same year she was then promoted to Community Health Nurse II at the Department of  
22 Public Health and Social Services; and

23           **WHEREAS**, in 1997, Gigi was appointed to serve as a Clinical Associate at the  
24 University of Guam, College of Nursing; and up until her retirement, Gigi had served  
25 as the Clinic Nurse Manager at the Department of Public Health and Social Services;  
26 and

1           **WHEREAS**, throughout her years on Guam, Ms. Quitariano provided her time  
2 and dedicated her service towards providing quality health care to the people of  
3 Guam. She received professional license certifications from the Guam Board of Nurse  
4 Examiners, to include Basic Life Support, Advance Cardiac Life Support, Intravenous  
5 Infusion, as well as Lamaze Instructor; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Gigi’s passion in the health care community brought numerous  
7 benefits to our island community. In fulfilling her duty as a registered nurse, she also  
8 acquired special trainings, courses, and attended conferences to enhance her skills and  
9 knowledge in order to become up to date with methods and materials to be provided to  
10 individuals; and

11           **WHEREAS**, among these include taking courses in Management in Health at  
12 the University of Guam, and attending the Pacific HIV/AIDS Clinical Conference in  
13 Hawai’i; as well as courses in Fundamentals of STD Intervention, and Psychosocial  
14 Counseling for the HIV Infected Person, to name a few; and

15           **WHEREAS**, Gigi’s hard work and commitment was greatly appreciated by the  
16 Department of Public Health and Social Services, where in 2003, she was given the  
17 award for “Supervisor of the Year” under the category of Nursing and Dental  
18 Hygiene; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Gigi’s services are truly appreciated by the island community.  
20 The nursing profession has a respectable reputation worldwide because their services  
21 extend from inquiries until the time of discharge. The responsibilities of nurses can be  
22 seen in various venues and institutions. Though their services vary, they continue to  
23 play an integral role in providing quality health care to the people of Guam; and

24           **WHEREAS**, the month of May is recognized as “Nurses Month,” and this  
25 year’s theme is: “Nurses: Delivering Quality & Innovation in Patient Care.” Gigi has  
26 done an exemplary job in the nursing profession, and throughout the years, she has

1 delivered quality and innovative methods in patient care; and her services are truly  
2 commendable and appreciated by the people of Guam; now therefore, be it
