2 ***GUÅHAN:***  
3           **WHEREAS, George Aguon Santos was born on December 2, 1952, and was**  
4 **raised in the village of *Mongmong*. He is the husband of Mrs. Rita Quitugua Santos;**

1 the dedicated father of Nathan P. Q. Santos and Sean D.Q. Santos; and is also blessed  
2 with two grandchildren; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 1970, George graduated from Father Dueñas Memorial School  
4 in *Mangilao*. He furthered his education at Marquette University in Milwaukee,  
5 Wisconsin, where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science in 1974,  
6 and he later attended the University of Guam, taking up graduate credits towards a  
7 Masters in Public Administration and Vocational Education; and

8 **WHEREAS**, George has extensive work experience, not only in the legislative  
9 and executive branches, but also in the private sector. His dedication to public service  
10 began in 1974, when he worked as a Budget Analyst for the Bureau of Budget and  
11 Management Research; and he later became a Fiscal Analyst at the Guam Legislature  
12 in 1975; and

13 **WHEREAS**, two (2) years later, George served as the Business Manager at the  
14 University of Guam, from 1977 to 1980; and in 1980, George became the Director of  
15 the Department of Administration, and served as Executive Director at the Governor's  
16 Office in 1981, later returning to the private sector in 1982 as a Manager for Marianas  
17 Real Estate Management Co., Ltd., and he later became a self-employed farmer until  
18 1984; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in 1984, George worked as an Account Executive for K-57 Radio,  
20 Inc., and in 1986, he became a Merchandiser/Manager for Atkins Kroll, Inc. He then  
21 returned to the government of Guam in 1989, where he worked as an Administrative  
22 Services Officer at the Department of Youth Affairs; and he later served as the  
23 Assistant Director of the Apprenticeship Training Program at the Guam Community  
24 College (GCC), from 1987 to 1997; and

25 **WHEREAS**, George continued working at the Guam Community College as  
26 the Assistant Director-Night Administrator for the School of Technology and Student

1 Services, from 1997 to 2004. From 2004 to 2012, George served as the Assistant  
2 Director of Apprenticeship Training for the GCC's School of Trades & Professional  
3 Services; and on March 1, 2012, George began working as the Director of the  
4 Department of Labor; and

5 **WHEREAS**, as the Director of Labor, George brought integrity back into the  
6 department, working with the Director of the Agency for Human Resources  
7 Development, advocating teamwork and instilling leadership with respect to program  
8 administrators, supervisors, and technical and clerical staff. George made respect the  
9 icing of his leadership, promoting the delivery of excellent customer services to  
10 America's Job Center; and

11 **WHEREAS**, George is a results-oriented leader with thirty (30) years of  
12 experience in the areas of management, finance, administration, education, and  
13 marketing, and his background includes work in both the public and private sectors,  
14 and holding elected positions and membership in religious organizations. His  
15 leadership style has proven to be successful, particularly in fostering collaborative  
16 teams and strategic management, in people management, analysis, communication and  
17 facilitation, and presentation and negotiation skills; and George has proven to be an  
18 individual of good moral character and high standards; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in addition to his many accomplishments, George has received  
20 specialized training in many specialties throughout the years, such as the Program  
21 Management and Budgeting with the U.S. Civil Service Commission in 1975;  
22 Records Management at the Department of Administration in 1987; Occupational  
23 Safety and Health for Safety Officers at the Department of Labor in 1989; Higher  
24 Education Administration and Organization at the Guam Community College in 1997;  
25 Critical Incident Stress Management at the University of Maryland in 2001; and from  
26 the Credit Union National Association: Consumer Lending Foundation School (Part

1 1) in 2001; Marketing Management Schools (Part 1) in 2001; Consumer Lending  
2 Management School (Part II) in 2002; Financial Management School (Part I) in 2002,  
3 and Leadership Development Institute in 2003; Ethics in the Public Sector at the  
4 USDA Graduate School in 2006; and the Supervisory Committee & Internal Audit  
5 Conference at the Credit Union National Association in 2007; and

6 **WHEREAS**, George has contributed to the community in many ways, to  
7 include his musical talents from 1977 to the present as a member of the Island  
8 Choralers, an all men's choir; and as the President of the *Nuestra Senor Del Las*  
9 *Aguas* Parish Council at the *Mongmong* Catholic Church. He also served as Chairman  
10 for four (4) terms, from 1992 to 2010, as an Elected Board Member of the Coast 360  
11 Federal Credit Union; and from 2004 to the present, as an active Elected Member of  
12 the Board of Trustees of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund; and

13 **WHEREAS**, George has decided to retire after thirty-six (36) years of public  
14 service, and he has left behind a positive work ethic, compassion and love for our  
15 island community, thus raising the bar for all future retirees with the government of  
16 Guam; now therefore, be it
