1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1775, two hundred thirty-eight years ago, our nation’s leaders
2 established the Continental Army, beginning a rich heritage of successfully defending
3 our country and its citizens; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Continental Army, which became the United States Army,
5 was established just as the Revolutionary War was underway, and was commanded by
6 General George Washington, the father of our Country, who after winning the war
7 became the First President of the United States; and

8 **WHEREAS**, from its birth on the Lexington Green to the present, the U.S.
9 Army has forged a proud history in defending the Nation with honor and distinction in
10 all its many wars and armed conflicts, most notably in the Civil War, World War I,
11 World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Panama, Grenada, the Persian Gulf
12 War, and currently in our peace mission in East Timor, in Indonesia, Bosnia, Africa,
13 Kosovo and the Global War on Terrorism (Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation
14 Enduring Freedom); and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Army’s 77th Infantry Division played a major role in
16 liberating Guam from enemy occupation in World War II, making the people of Guam
17 forever grateful to the Army for its part in the island’s liberation many years ago; and

18 **WHEREAS**, since the end of World War II, thousands of Guam’s young men
19 and women have joined the U.S. Army and have distinguished themselves for their
20 valor and dedication, many of whom have sacrificed their lives in war conflicts in
21 regions around the world; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the American Army, first and always, is the people, with a broad
23 foundation of national support symbolized by the endless rows of yellow ribbons and
24 the American flags which bedeck the country from coast to coast on Independence
25 Day, as the Nation and the Army continues to shape into the 21st century to meet
26 future changes, and with all Americans seeking to maintain the continuity of

1 capabilities and commitment that has made the Army what it is today - the financial
2 bastion of defense of the American people and the American way of life; and

3 **WHEREAS**, this 238th birthday commemorates America’s Army, its soldiers,
4 families and civilians, who are achieving a level of excellence that is truly Army
5 Strong; and

6 **WHEREAS**, we also celebrate the people of Guam’s steadfast support of our
7 soldiers and families with this year’s theme of “America’s Army: Service to the
8 Nation, Strength for the Future”; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the principles of democracy and freedom as documented in the
10 Constitution of the United States are what the U.S. Army stands ready to protect and
11 defend for its citizens; and

12 **WHEREAS**, approximately 600 Guam Army National Guardsmen, responding
13 to the call of duty, recently deployed to Afghanistan, marking one of the largest
14 deployments in Guam Army Guard history; and

15 **WHEREAS**, families have provided tremendous support to their soldiers
16 during times of training and deployment, and whose care has fostered the
17 accomplishments of each and every man and woman who proudly serve (past and
18 present) in the U.S. Army; now therefore, be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Dos Na*
20 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
21 of Guam, honor, commend and congratulate the numerous Guam service members of
22 the United States Army, Active, Reserve and Retirees, on the celebration of the U.S.
23 Army’s 238th birthday on June 14, 2013, and does recognize them for their
24 tremendous service in the defense of freedom for Guam and the United States of
25 America; and does further extend a heartfelt *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu’os Ma’åse’* to the

1 soldiers and their families for their contributions and dedication to our community and
2 the people of Guam; and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
4 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
5 the same be thereafter transmitted to the United States Army, Guam Army National
6 Guard, Army Reserve, Army Retirees, Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 668 and
7 all Army Veterans; the Honorable Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Guam Delegate to the
8 United States House of Representatives; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I*
9 *Maga•låhen Guåhan.*


