3 **WHEREAS, Specialist Dwayne Westfall Flores, a resident of *Sinajaña*, Guam,**
4 **lived a humble and honorable life as a son, brother, friend, and soldier who ultimately**

1 sacrificed his life to protect the values of freedom and democracy for his family, the
2 people of Guam, and our country; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores served proudly as a member of the United States
4 Armed Forces, specifically, the Guam Army National Guard; and

5 **WHEREAS**, on May 19, 2008, Specialist Flores enlisted in the Guam Army
6 National Guard and was assigned to Headquarters & Headquarters Company, 1st
7 Battalion, 294th Infantry Regiment; and he was last assigned to Echo Company, 1st
8 Battalion, 294th Infantry Regiment; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores, along with his comrade, Sergeant Eugene M.
10 Aguon, died in the line of duty on May 16, 2013, when enemy forces attacked their
11 unit with a vehicle-borne improvised explosive device in Kabul, Afghanistan; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores and Sergeant Aguon were part of approximately
13 600 Guam Army National Guardsmen who left the island on March 2, 2013, for a
14 month of pre-deployment training at Camp Shelby in Mississippi, and then deployed
15 to Afghanistan in April 2013; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores was among the hundreds of thousands of brave
17 men and women serving in the United States Armed Forces who selflessly gave their
18 lives in the fight for our freedom, of which we are forever indebted; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores' efforts have contributed to the level of
20 excellence of the United States Army, as it celebrates its 238th year anniversary on
21 June 14, 2013; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores leaves a legacy by joining our fallen heroes who
23 have sought to maintain peace and protect our freedom, of which our island shall
24 dutifully pay homage and respect to; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores’ awards and achievements include the following:
2 the Bronze Star Medal (posthumous); the Purple Heart Medal (posthumous); the
3 Combat Action Badge (posthumous); the Army Good Conduct Medal (posthumous);
4 the National Defense Service Medal; the Army Service Ribbon; the Army Reserve
5 Component Overseas Training Ribbon; and the Guam Cross of Valor (posthumous);
6 and

7 **WHEREAS**, the honor and memory of Specialist Flores will live on through
8 his family, his fellow service members, and the people of Guam; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Flores, at the tender age of 22, now enters a new life of
10 promised peace, untainted by the anguish of violence and war, where he will continue
11 to look over and protect our island and nation; now therefore, be it

12 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’ Trentai Dos Na*
13 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
14 grateful people of Guam, recognize, honor and memorialize Specialist Dwayne
15 Westfall Flores for his brave and selfless act in the ultimate service to his family,
16 Guam and our nation; and does further extend a special tribute of gratitude to his
17 family for their invaluable support of his service to his beloved island of Guam and
18 the United States of America; and be it further

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
20 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
21 the same be thereafter transmitted to the family of Specialist Dwayne Westfall Flores;




