1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS, Sergeant Eugene M. Aguon, a resident of *Mangilao*, Guam, lived**  
4 **a humble and honorable life as a son, brother, friend, and soldier who ultimately**

1 sacrificed his life to protect the values of freedom and democracy for his family, the  
2 people of Guam, and our country; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon graduated from George Washington High  
4 School, and went on to serve proudly as a member of the United States Armed Forces,  
5 specifically, the Guam Army National Guard; and

6 **WHEREAS**, on September 25, 2006, Sergeant Aguon enlisted in the Guam  
7 Army National Guard, and was assigned to Foxtrot Company, 29<sup>th</sup> Brigade Support  
8 Battalion, 29<sup>th</sup> Infantry Brigade Combat Team; and on December 15, 2009, Sergeant  
9 Aguon transferred to Headquarters & Headquarters Company, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 294<sup>th</sup>  
10 Infantry Regiment; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon had served on a prior deployment to Kuwait and  
12 Iraq, from October 31, 2008, to March 15, 2010; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon was last assigned to Echo Company, 1<sup>st</sup>  
14 Battalion, 294<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 29<sup>th</sup> Infantry Brigade Combat Team; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon, along with his comrade, Specialist Dwayne W.  
16 Flores, died in the line of duty on May 16, 2013, when enemy forces attacked their  
17 unit with a vehicle-borne improvised explosive device in Kabul, Afghanistan; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon and Specialist Flores were part of approximately  
19 600 Guam Army National Guardsmen who left the island on March 2, 2013, for a  
20 month of pre-deployment training at Camp Shelby in Mississippi, and then deployed  
21 to Afghanistan in April 2013; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon was among the hundreds of thousands of brave  
23 men and women serving in the United States Armed Forces who selflessly gave their  
24 lives in the fight for our freedom, for which we are forever indebted; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon’s efforts have contributed to the level of  
2 excellence of the United States Army as it celebrates its 238<sup>th</sup> year anniversary on  
3 June 14, 2013; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon leaves a legacy by joining our fallen heroes who  
5 have sought to maintain peace and protect our freedom, of which our island shall  
6 dutifully pay homage and respect to; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon’s awards and achievements include: the Bronze  
8 Star Medal (posthumous); the Purple Heart Medal (posthumous); the Combat  
9 Infantryman Badge (posthumous); the Army Achievement Medal the Army Good  
10 Conduct Medal; the Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal; the National  
11 Defense Service Medal; the Iraqi Campaign Medal – Two Campaign Stars; the Global  
12 War on Terror – Expeditionary Medal; the Global War on Terror – Service Medal; the  
13 Armed Forces Reserve Medal, with “M” Device; the Army Service Ribbon; the  
14 Overseas Service Ribbon; the Army Reserve Component Overseas Training Ribbon;  
15 the Non-commissioned Officer Professional Development Training Ribbon; and the  
16 Guam Cross of Valor (posthumous); and

17           **WHEREAS**, the honor and memory of Sergeant Aguon will live on through his  
18 family, his fellow service members, and the people of Guam; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Aguon, at the tender age of 23, now enters a new life of  
20 promised peace, untainted by the anguish of violence and war, where he will continue  
21 to look over and protect our island and nation; now therefore, be it


22           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Dos Na*

26 our nation; and does further extend sincere condolences and a special tribute of


1 gratitude to his family for their invaluable support of his service to his beloved island
