1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I
2 *MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

1 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux (DLX) International Fraternity and
2 Sorority is an elite international fraternity and sorority that includes college,
3 business and professional individuals who are strategically-focused on
4 exemplifying the DLX core values of brotherhood and sisterhood, and
5 intellectual, cultural, social, physical and spiritual welfare; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity and Sorority was
7 founded worldwide by a visionary who was inspired by the original fifteen
8 (15) grand founding fathers of Domino Lux Philippines. DLX was established
9 on September 20, 1974, and originated from De La Salle University in the
10 Republic of the Philippines; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in many countries, different senior fraternities and
12 sororities have joined, thus making DLX a way to experience the ultimate
13 encounter of camaraderie. DLX has amplified in ranks from a chosen few, and
14 it has gained much deserved recognition, and is embraced by many; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International members are committed as
16 an unstoppable force to grow in excellence in every aspect of each other's
17 lives, and capitalize on deepest camaraderie aligned to the light of God, the
18 glory of their families, the receptiveness to good causes, and the means for the
19 fulfillment of humanity; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter,
21 was established on Guam on June 18, 2008, with eighteen (18) original
22 founding members of the Chapter; and in five (5) years it has grown its
23 membership to over 1,000 brothers and sisters, which has been credited much

1 to the ability of each of its members to aggressively recruit new members
2 because of the organization's dynamic support, internally, of each other, and
3 of its support to the island community. The Guam Chapter has been
4 recognized as the Domino Lux International Fraternity Headquarters; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter,
6 expanded its foundational base in January 2012 with four (4) founding
7 members, to include the establishment of a Domino Lux International
8 Sorority, Guam, which similarly promotes and advocates its core values and
9 principles among its female members on Guam, in the advancement of
10 sisterhood and community, and it has grown to over 150 members; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the following individuals have taken leadership roles in
12 DLX International Fraternity and Sorority: Danny Leon Guerrero, Country
13 Grand Magister; Vic Pasetes, Chapter Grand Magister; Craig Cruz, Chapter
14 Grand Vitium Magister; Allen Santos, Charta Custos; Senator Dennis
15 Rodriguez, Jr., Internus Cognatus; Jose S. San Agustin, Externus Cognatus;
16 John Sablan, Delectus Prefectus; Elbert Piolo, Securitas Prefectus; Senator
17 Frank B. Aguon, Jr., Chapter Grand Council; Lorna Francisco, Chapter Grand
18 Magister; Jennifer Aguon, Chapter Grand Vitium Magister; Neline Cruz,
19 Aerarium Odis; Rosette Pasetes, Externus Cognatus; and Angustia Flores,
20 Chapter Grand Council; and

21 **WHEREAS**, since its initial establishment, the Domino Lux International
22 Fraternity and Sorority, Guam Chapter, has continued to contribute its time,
23 talents, and support to the local community through frequent activities

1 throughout the year, to include: the adoption of bus stops in conjunction with
2 the Islandwide Beautification Task Force; participating in anti-bullying
3 campaigns at the island's public schools; holding carwashes to benefit
4 typhoon and earthquake victims in the Philippines; the DLX Prison Outreach,
5 in which the Guam Chapter and the Philippines Chapter conducted bible
6 study, counseling, and heart-to-heart talks with inmates with the goal of
7 turning the prisoners' lives around; sponsoring a Christmas food relief drive
8 for more than 200 families living along the old national railways in Barangay
9 Inosluban Lipa City; supporting the annual Special Olympics by mentoring
10 the special athletes and facilitating the awarding of the winners; and the
11 annual spiritual drive around the island during Lenten season; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the members of the Domino Lux International Fraternity
13 and Sorority, Guam Chapter, have successfully hosted annual signature
14 events, such as the DLX Peace Festival, which promotes the brotherhood and
15 sisterhood and commemorates the month of June as the founding month of
16 DLX International; the DLX Annual Red Carpet Ball in celebration of the
17 organization's founding day; and DLX Family Day; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Domino Lux International established the Guam
19 International Boxing Council (GIBC) last year in August 2012 that adeptly
20 took Guam by storm in promoting Amateur Boxing and Kickboxing; now
21 therefore, be it


22 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina Trentai Dos Na*
23 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the

1 people of Guam, recognize and commend the Domino Lux International

3 organization in welcoming another momentous year of the DLX Peace
4 Festival; and does further extend a warm *Un Dãngkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ãse'* and
5 *Maraming Salamat Po'* to DLX for its achievements in upholding the core
6 values the prestigious organization is founded under; and be it further
7 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on

12 *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


