- 5 Parks and Recreation Pool and Beach Section, during which time he taught hundreds
- 6 of people in water safety, and he also performed rescues that saved many lives; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Torres, as an accomplished athlete, represented Guam and competed in windsurfing at the 1988 Olympic Games in Seoul, South Korea, and participated in three of the South Pacific Games in New Caledonia (1987), in Papua Nui Guinea (1991), in Tahiti (1995), and Guam (1999); and WHEREAS, Mr. Torres worked at the Guam Historic Preservation Office of the Department of Parks and Recreation, serving as an Archaeological Technician and Historic Preservation Specialist; and where he introduced Geographic Information System (GIS)/Global Positioning Systems (GPS) technology into the Department of Parks and Recreation for the Historic Preservation Program; and WHEREAS, Mr. Torres joined the Bureau of Statistics and Plans in 2004,
