6 Guam's construction industry, leading the way in systems design, quality control,
7 and technological advances, specifically in coatings, decorative finishes and
8 building claddings; and

1 **WHEREAS**, *Isla* Paint and Roofing Supply was awarded as the “Best in
2 their Class” and currently has more than four million square feet of fluid applied to
3 roofing under warrant on Andersen Air Force Base and Big Navy, and more than
4 one million square feet of EFS/EIFS systems installed on the bases; and
