3 **WHEREAS**, Sophia S.N. Dueñas is the daughter of the late and former Mayor
4 Vicente and Teresita San Nicolas of *Chalan Pago*, and is the eighth child of eleven
5 children; and she is the proud mother of Erin Bryce, Sia Erice and Samyra Tate; and

6 **WHEREAS**, growing up in *Chalan Pago*, Sophia attended Kindergarten at
7 *Ordot-Chalan Pago* Elementary School; 1st and 2nd grade at St. Francis School in

1 *Yona*; 3rd, 4th and 5th grade at San Vicente School in *Barrigada*; 6th through 8th grade
2 at Agueda I. Johnston Middle School in *Ordot*; and 9th through 12th grade at George
3 Washington High School in *Mangilao*; and

4 **WHEREAS**, while attending George Washington High School, Sophia graduated
5 tenth in her class of the GWHS Class of 1990, and she was involved and participated in
6 many extra and co-curricular activities such as: GW Girls' Varsity Volleyball (9th
7 through 12th grade); three years with the GW Track and Field (high jump, long jump,
8 javelin, and discus); Senator with the GWHS Junior Class Council; Activity Coordinator
9 of the Senior Class Council; SBA Activity Coordinator; National Honor Society; Guam
10 Junior National Volleyball Team, 1991 Asian Pacific Games; 1990 Micronesian Games;
11 and the Guam National Volleyball Team, 1991 South Pacific Games; and

12 **WHEREAS**, from 1990 to 1994, Sophia attended the University of Guam, where
13 she was a member of the UOG Volleyball Team, and the UOG MATH Club; and

14 **WHEREAS**, upon her graduation from the University of Guam in December
15 1994, Sophia received her BA degree in Secondary Education with specialization in
16 Mathematics, and she continued on to receive her Master's degree in Administration and
17 Supervision in December 2008; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Sophia received trainings in AP Calculus and AP Vertical
19 Alignment, and throughout her teaching career, Sophia received numerous certificates
20 and awards to include: Certified Master Educator in Mathematics; Certified Professional
21 II in Administration and Supervision; *Piti* Middle School 8th grade Mathematics, from
22 January to June 1995; and GWHS Mathematics, 9th through 12th grades, from August
23 1995 to June 2004 (Pre-algebra, Algebra A, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II,
24 Trigonometry, Elementary Functions); and

25 **WHEREAS**, Sophia's career as an Administrator in education includes serving as
26 Assistant Principal of Curriculum at GWHS, from July 2004 to July 2013; and

27 **WHEREAS**, while serving as Assistant Principal at GWHS, Sophia assisted in
28 the implementation of the School-To-Work Program, a Board of Education approved

1 course; she was involved with other programs, such as: the Ninth Grade Academy; the
2 BACT (Business Academy and Computer Technology) Academy; the PAA (Personal
3 Adult Advocate) Program under Breaking Ranks II; GWii (George Washington
4 Instructional Intervention); PLC (Professional Learning Communities); and Professional
5 Learning Trainings during teacher prep periods; and she implemented the STEM
6 (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) Program; and


7 **WHEREAS**, under Sophia's leadership as Assistant Principal of Curriculum,
