1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, the United States Coast Guard, a branch of the U.S. Armed  
4 Forces, was founded in August of 1790 by then-Treasury Secretary Alexander  
5 Hamilton, and it is the oldest seagoing service in the United States Armed Forces;  
6 and

7           **WHEREAS**, in 1939, the United States Congress established a Coast Guard  
8 Reserve, administered by the Coast Guard Commandant, to be composed of  
9 unpaid, volunteer U.S. citizens who own motorboats or yachts; and

10           **WHEREAS**, on June 23, 1941, Congress created a military Reserve within  
11 the Coast Guard, and renamed the original volunteer Reserve as the “Coast Guard  
12 Auxiliary”; and

13           **WHEREAS**, today, the Auxiliary remains a volunteer organization, and  
14 Guam’s very own Flotilla 140-02-24, established in April 1973, continues to  
15 provide services to our local community; and

16           **WHEREAS**, during the forty years of existence of the Guam Flotilla, more  
17 than 200 Guamanians have volunteered thousands of hours annually, contributing  
18 their time and the use of their personal vessels, for the safety and security of our  
19 citizens and visitors in port facilities and waterways, with the Guam Flotilla  
20 providing free vessel safety checks, harbor patrols, safe boating education courses,  
21 search and rescue operations, and marine environmental protection; and

22           **WHEREAS**, the Auxiliary is a force multiplier for U.S. Coast Guard Sector  
23 Guam and Station Apra Harbor, with the Auxiliary providing coverage and safety  
24 at special events throughout the year, including the Marianas Yacht Club Regatta,  
25 the Cocos Island Swim, the Marianas Fishing Derby, and other events sponsored  
26 by the Guam Fishermen’s Cooperative Association; and

27           **WHEREAS**, the Auxiliary’s voluntary role of providing maritime safety  
28 and assisting in training and search and rescue functions has been an enormous  
29 benefit to the people of Guam, and also to our many visitors who love to enjoy our  
30 island’s warm sun, sand and seas; now therefore, be it

31           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
32 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the members of  
33 the Guam Flotilla of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary on the celebration of the 40<sup>th</sup>

34 Anniversary of the Guam Flotilla, and the 73<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary of the U.S. Coast  
35 Guard Auxiliary; and does further extend *Un Dãngkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ãse'* to  
36 them for all their hard work and service to the people of Guam; and be it further

37 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest  
38 to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to  
39 Captain Casey White, USCG Sector Guam Commander; to Clarence Feagin,  
40 USCG Auxiliary Flotilla Commander; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I*  
41 *Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
