1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Ernest “Ernie” E. Caseres, Planner III, retires on July 1, 2013,  
4 after completing thirty years of government service at the Bureau of Statistics and  
5 Plans (Bureau of Planning); and

6           **WHEREAS**, in 1983, Mr. Caseres graduated from the University of Guam with  
7 degrees in Business Administration and Political Science; and

1           **WHEREAS**, to help fund his college education, Ernie had worked at a  
2 Kentucky Fried Chicken restaurant, from 1980 to 1983; and

3           **WHEREAS**, in 1984, Mr. Caseres began his career with the government of  
4 Guam working as a Planner I with the Socio Economic Division, Bureau of Planning;  
5 and

6           **WHEREAS**, through satisfactory performances of his job tasks, Ernie was  
7 elevated to the position of a Planner II in 1985, and again promoted as a Planner III in  
8 1990; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Caseres has served under eight executive branch  
10 administrations, including with three Governors serving two consecutive four year  
11 terms; he has served under nine Directors, and had been with the Department as it  
12 went through the merger of the Department of Commerce and the Guam Health  
13 Planning Division, and the name change from the Bureau of Planning, to the Bureau  
14 of Statistics and Plans; and

15           **WHEREAS**, for his outstanding achievement in 1990, Ernie received a  
16 commendation for his efforts in coordinating the completion of applications to obtain  
17 surplus federal property for the new Guam Community College campus, the new  
18 Southern High School, and the *Agat* Treatment Facility; in 1994, he was again  
19 recognized for his efforts to complete the Team Guam Report, "The Next Liberation,"  
20 for the Land Summit; and he received other recognitions for his professionalism and  
21 outstanding performance of his job tasks and duties; and

22           **WHEREAS**, in his thirty years of government service, Ernie has been involved  
23 in complex, sensitive projects, to include, social, economic, environmental and capital  
24 improvement planning, government reorganization, organized and administered  
25 research studies, analyses in land use, infrastructure improvement, environmental  
26 requirements, the initial application and release of federal lands, Guam excess lands,

1 the DoD 1994 Guam Land Use Plan, the DoD Closure and Realignment  
2 Recommendations for BRAC 95, federal constraints, state clearinghouse technical  
3 reviews, implementation and administration of criminal justice grants, the  
4 coordination of numerous regional and international organizations, he provided  
5 numerous legislative reviews and testimonies, he served as the liaison with public and  
6 private organizations, and served in numerous strategic planning council and  
7 coordinating committees, to name just a few; and

8       **WHEREAS**, as a long-time employee of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans, Mr.  
9 Ernest Caseres is recognized for his outstanding work for the Bureau, and he will be  
10 missed for his invaluable and institutional knowledge, and his contributions to the  
11 island's social, physical, economic and environmental development. His success and  
12 professionalism was greatly appreciated by his colleagues, who also wish to express a  
13 sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* to his wife, Emily R. Caseres, his children,  
14 Kassundra Marie and Keith Matthew, and his son-in-law, Daryl Blas, in recognition of  
15 their support during his thirty years of service; and


16       **WHEREAS**, in addition, Ernie's colleagues further extend best wishes to him

19 to his heart's content on his Harley Davidson Street Glide; now therefore, be it


20       **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
