3 **WHEREAS**, LTC Angel Bermudez, a native of Guam, graduated from the
4 University of Hawaii at Manoa in 1992, where he earned a Bachelor of Science
5 Degree in Anthropology; and he was then commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in
6 the U.S. Army Armor Corps; and

7 **WHEREAS**, LTC Bermudez is married to the former Ruth-Lee Cooper of
8 Bournemouth, England, and they have 2 wonderful daughters, Lilly June and Leilani
9 Kai; and

1 **WHEREAS**, LTC Bermudez is a graduate of the Armor Officer Basic Course
2 and Field Artillery Advance Course at Fort Sill, Oklahoma; and graduated from the
3 Combined Arms Services Support School (CAS3), the Scout Platoon Leaders
4 Course, the Cavalry Leaders Course, the Anti-Terrorism Level II Course, and the
5 Command General Staff Course (CGSC) at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas; and

6 **WHEREAS**, LTC Bermudez enlisted in the Hawaii Army National Guard in
7 1988 and was assigned to Troop E, 19th Cavalry in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1992, LTC Bermudez began active duty service as a Tank
9 Platoon Leader, Tank Company Executive Officer; and Headquarters &
10 Headquarters Company Executive Officer with the 4th Battalion, 67th Armor in
11 Friedberg, Germany; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 1996, LTC Bermudez was deployed as part of the
13 Implementation Forces (IFOR) to Bosnia and Herzegovina; and

14 **WHEREAS**, after his completion of the Field Artillery Advance Course at Fort
15 Sill, Oklahoma, LTC Bermudez was assigned to serve as an Operations Officer and
16 Commander, K Troop, 3rd Squadron, 2nd Armored Cavalry Regiment at Fort Polk,
17 Louisiana; and in 1997 during his tour with the Regiment, LTC Bermudez
18 conducted a 2nd deployment to Bosnia and Herzegovina as part of the Stabilization
19 Forces (SFOR); and

20 **WHEREAS**, LTC Bermudez's next assignment was served as an Operations
21 Officer with the 5th Brigade (TSB), 78th Division at Fort Meade, Maryland; and in
22 2002, his career path took him to Doha, Qatar, where he accepted an assignment to
23 work as the Operations Officer for ARCENT-Qatar, located at Camp As-Sayliyah;
24 and

25 **WHEREAS**, in 2004, after the completion of his 27 month Middle Eastern
26 tour, LTC Bermudez attended the Command and General Staff College (CGSC) at
27 Fort Leavenworth, Kansas; and

1 **WHEREAS**, immediately following his graduation from the CGSC, LTC
2 Bermudez was appointed to serve as the Operations Officer for the 3rd Squadron, 4th
3 Calvary, 3rd Brigade, 25th Division at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii; and during the
4 Division's deployment in 2007, LTC Bermudez assumed the position as the G3
5 (REAR), 25th ID; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 2008, LTC Bermudez' next assignment was with the 3rd
7 Squadron, 16th Calvary at Fort Knox, Kentucky, where he held the position of
8 Squadron Executive Officer; and

9 **WHEREAS**, prior to arriving on Guam, LTC Bermudez was deployed to Iraq
10 serving as a Security Assistant Officer (Foreign Military Sales) with the Multi-
11 National Security Transition Command in Baghdad, Iraq; and

12 **WHEREAS**, LTC Bermudez' awards include the Bronze Star Medal; the
13 Defense Meritorious Service Medal; the Meritorious Service Medal (30LC); the
14 Army Commendation Medal (20LC); the Army Achievement Medal (30LC); the
15 National Defense Service Medal (w/ Bronze Star); the Joint Meritorious Unit Award
16 (20LC); the Army Superior Unit Award; the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal;
17 the Iraqi Campaign Medal (w/ Campaign Star); the Armed Forces Service Medal;
18 the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; and Global War on Terrorism
19 Expeditionary Medal; and

20 **WHEREAS**, furthermore, LTC Bermudez' skill badges include both the
21 Airborne and the Air Assault Badges; now therefore, be it

25 Battalion, 196th Infantry Brigade; and be it further


26 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
