1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURANGUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, “Parks and Recreation Month” is traditionally celebrated annually**
4 **during the month of July, and the Department of Parks and Recreation is continuing**
5 **that tradition in the celebration by adopting this year’s “Parks and Recreation Month”**

1 theme: “Protecting our Historic and Natural Resources to Enhance Our Quality of
2 Life”; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the official purpose of “Parks and Recreation Month” is to invite
4 public participation in activities that enhance our people’s quality of life at a
5 community level, and in so doing, heighten public awareness regarding the
6 importance of the Department of Parks & Recreation; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation performs a wide variety
8 of parks, recreation and historic preservation services for our community; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation is committed to
10 improving the quality of life for our residents, and for our visitors, by promoting
11 healthy lifestyles, strengthening our families, maintaining our parks and natural areas,
12 and preserving our island’s unique heritage; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation continues to properly
14 maintain and operate our parks and recreational facilities, and ensures that all parks,
15 equipment, and facilities are safe, attractive, accessible, and user-friendly; and also
16 ensures that our island’s historic sites are protected and restored for the benefit of
17 present and future generations; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation provides activities that
19 can reduce stress, provide socialization opportunities, and improve the mental and
20 physical well-being of our youth, adults, seniors, and challenged individuals; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation also recognizes the
22 importance of our rich heritage through the preservation of our many historic sites,
23 and acknowledging Guam’s Pre-Contact, Spanish, Early American, Japanese/World
24 War II and Post War Historic Timelines; and

25 **WHEREAS**, for the past 38 years, the Department of Parks and Recreation has
26 been mandated by law to be responsible for 76 active parks and over four thousand

1 seven hundred ninety-four acres of seashore, conservation and wildlife refuge, and is
2 also responsible to protect and maintain over one thousand six hundred historic sites
3 in its inventory; additionally, they review over one thousand one hundred building
4 permits annually to ensure that historic sites are taken into consideration; and they
5 also process over one thousand four hundred park permits, more than twenty vendor
6 permits, and over one hundred fifty facility permits annually, so that island residents
7 and visitors alike can enjoy the outdoor environment at our beaches and parks; and


8 **WHEREAS,** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes the contributions of
9 community partners, such as Ms. Paula Faulk Creech, American Samoa, and
10 Micronesia Historic Preservation Program (National Park Service), who has
11 committed to assisting the Guam Historic Preservation Office; and the War in the
12 Pacific National Park (National Park Service), the Guam Preservation Trust, the
13 Department of *Chamorro* Affairs, the Guam Museum, the Guam Museum
14 Foundation, the University of Guam, the Richard F. Flores Micronesian Area
15 Research Center, the Pacific War Museum, the Guam Visitors Bureau, the Guam
16 Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA), the Guam Economic
17 Development Authority (GEDA), the Mayors Council of Guam (MCOG) and the
18 Department of Corrections (DOC), that have steadfastly supported the Department of
19 Parks and Recreation and have contributed to the preservation, protection and
20 interpretation of Guam’s historic and cultural resources, as well as the beautification
21 and maintenance of our parks and recreational facilities; now therefore, be it

22 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
23 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
24 of Guam, commend and congratulate the Employees of the Department of Parks and
25 Recreation for their many accomplishments as they celebrate their 38th Year
26 Anniversary, and the observance of “Parks and Recreation Month” during the month


1 of July 2013, with the theme: "Protecting our Historic and Natural Resources to
2 Enhance our Quality of Life"; and does further extend *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os*
3 *Ma'ase'* to them for the invaluable services that they provide to the people of Guam;
