3 **WHEREAS**, as a local telecommunications corporation, one of IT&E's core
4 values is *Strengthening Commitment* in providing world class solutions and
5 performances through unparalleled telecommunications services to its customers, and
6 the people of Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS**, many of IT&E's core values involve embracing change and staying
8 focused on the future of a world in motion; valuing customer satisfaction as its reason
9 for excellence and committing to the welfare of communities and its families; opening

1 minds to new ideas to improve products and services, and being dedicated to
2 dependability and reliability; and accepting the challenge of seeking out innovative
3 solutions and enhancing knowledge through training and experience to support world
4 class services; and

5 **WHEREAS**, IT&E had made a promise, when its current ownership acquired the
6 telecommunications assets of IT&E Overseas, Inc. in 2008, that IT&E would continue
7 in its long standing legacy as a responsible corporate citizen since its original
8 incorporation in 1979; and

9 **WHEREAS**, IT&E's commitment to the welfare of our community and families is
10 manifested through IT&E's playground projects in Guam and the CNMI, in which
11 IT&E initially donated and installed seven playgrounds in the villages of *Mongmong-*
12 *Toto-Maite, Hagåtña, Merizo, Mangilao, Dededo* and *Barrigada* in the 1990s; and

13 **WHEREAS**, IT&E renewed the playground projects recently with the donation of
14 two new playgrounds in Saipan, and three new playgrounds on Guam in the villages
15 of *Umatac* and *Mangilao*, and at *Ypao* Beach Park; and

16 **WHEREAS**, IT&E has made tremendous efforts to improve lives via wireless
17 broadband access and adoption; and some of IT&E's recent donations of wireless
18 broadband services to the community include: the Guam Public Library System's
19 satellite branches in *Merizo, Agat, Yona, Barrigada* and *Dededo* (February 2013); the
20 Guam Cancer Care's "Live, Fight, Survive Health Fair and Cancer Screening" event
21 (April 2013); the Guam Library Association's "Pacific Island Association of
22 Libraries, Archives and Museum Conference" (November 2012); the Department of
23 Public Health and Social Services' "Island Wide Health Fair" (October 2012); and the
24 Guam Association of Realtors' "Guam Homeownership Expo" (October 2012); and

25 **WHEREAS**, through IT&E's Charitable Giving Policy, it understands its role as a
26 business leader in the communities it serves; it accepts the responsibility to set a
27 higher standard for regional corporate citizenship; and it is committed to supporting

1 programs that are closely aligned with IT&E's defined charitable giving guidelines;
2 and

3 **WHEREAS**, additionally, IT&E's charitable focus favors organizations, events
4 and programs that benefit the education, health and welfare of Guam's children and
5 their families. IT&E recognizes the importance and opportunity of diversity; and it
6 supports programs and initiatives that encourage the development of minority and
