2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

1       **WHEREAS**, the Iloilo International of Guam is a Filipino organization whose  
2 ideals are to promote the “*bayanihan*” spirit and camaraderie between and among the  
3 *Ilongos* on Guam and throughout the United States; and

4       **WHEREAS**, the Iloilo International also strives to promote and maintain social,  
5 civic, and cultural ties with *Ilonggos*, as well as to encourage those with talents in the  
6 fields of education, science, sports, arts and business; and

7       **WHEREAS**, the organization finds the importance in preserving the ethnic  
8 traditions, customs and history of the *Ilonggos*, and promote the development of  
9 cultural and social growth of our youth. In doing so, the Iloilo International of Guam  
10 also promotes the principles of integrity, opportunity, establishment and equal access  
11 to participate fully in the life of the community; and

12       **WHEREAS**, the vision of these individuals came to reality when a group of  
13 *Ilongos* on Guam, led by Charter President Art O. Salomes, organized the non-  
14 profit/non-sectarian civic association on January 1, 2008; and

15       **WHEREAS**, since the establishment of the association, the Iloilo International of  
16 Guam has participated in fundraisers and special events benefiting many charitable  
17 organizations, including: the collection of donations for the victims of the Typhoon  
18 *Frank* calamity in 2008, and Typhoon *Sendong* in 2012; and

19       **WHEREAS**, other donations of services and monetary donations by the  
20 organization were given to *Kamalen Karidat*, the St. Dominic Senior Care Center,  
21 Sanctuary, Inc., and the World Youth Day Trip for *Dededo*; and they had sponsored a  
22 student to represent Guam for a band competition in Korea, and have participated in  
23 civic activities benefitting the beautification of Guam; and

24       **WHEREAS**, the majority of the members who are *Ilonggos* recognize Guam as  
25 their home, and one of the main objectives of the Iloilo International of Guam is to be

26 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted Jesusa B.


