3       **WHEREAS**, the anniversary of the 9/11 attacks in New York and the Pentagon  
4 has reminded us that hundreds of thousands of our fellow citizen-service members  
5 continue to serve and maintain constant vigilance in order to protect our freedom and  
6 the American way of life; and

7       **WHEREAS**, standing tall among these troops are our nation’s National Guard and  
8 Reserve forces, which continue to serve our island and country with distinction. Our  
9 National Guardsmen and Reservists continue to serve on active duty on every front of  
10 the Global War on Terror; and

11       **WHEREAS**, almost half of our military force resides in the Reserve Components,  
12 which is comprised of the National Guard and Reserve; and

13       **WHEREAS**, the organization, the Guam-CNMI Committee for Employer Support  
14 of the Guard and Reserve, through its volunteers and employers, support this effort  
15 and provide a degree of comfort for members of the National Guard and Reserve so  
16 that they can focus on their military mission without worrying about their civilian jobs

7 between employers and service members; and be it further


8       **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the
