3 **WHEREAS, Captain Casey J. White is originally from Colorado; and she is a**
4 **1989 graduate of the United States Coast Guard Academy in New London,**

1 Connecticut, where she earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical
2 Engineering; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Captain White is married to Mr. Jay Baker, and she enjoys paddle
4 boarding and golfing during her free time; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Captain White also earned a Master of Science degree in
6 Operations Research from Georgia Institute of Technology in Atlanta, Georgia, in
7 2002; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 2011, Captain White earned her Master's in Strategic Studies
9 from the U.S. Marine War College in Quantico, Virginia; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in July of 2011, Captain White assumed command of Coast
11 Guard Sector Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, as Sector Commander, Captain White is by statute the Captain of
13 the Port, the Federal Maritime Security Coordinator, the Officer in Charge of
14 Marine Inspections, and the Federal On-Scene Coordinator for Guam and the
15 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI); and

16 **WHEREAS**, Captain White is also the Search and Rescue Mission
17 Coordinator for nearly two million square nautical miles of the Western Pacific
18 Ocean, to include the waters of the Federated States of Micronesia and Palau; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Coast Guard Sector Guam's assets include the 110-foot
20 patrol boats, the USCGC ASSATEAGUE and the USCGC WASHINGTON;
21 Station Apra Harbor, with two 45-foot and one 25-foot response boats; and a staff of
22 160 active duty and civilian personnel responsible for performing all Coast Guard
23 missions; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Captain White served in a variety of operational assignments,
25 both afloat and ashore; and

26 **WHEREAS**, Captain White served as a Deck Watch Officer aboard the
27 USCGC Decisive, home ported in St. Petersburg, Florida; as the Commanding
28 Officer of the USCGC DRUMMOND, home ported in Cape Canaveral, Florida; as

1 the Operations Officer aboard the USCGC MELLON, home ported in Seattle,
2 Washington; and as a Deputy Sector Commander for Sector Charleston, South
3 Carolina; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Captain White lead Sector Guam and Cutters in presenting school
5 supplies to *Merizo* Elementary School, which is the Coast Guard’s adopted sister-
6 school, every year on Career Day; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Captain White donated her time, personnel, and supplies to paint
8 the *Merizo* Elementary School, as well as participating in tutoring and reading
9 programs; and

10 **WHEREAS**, through the U.S. Coast Guard Angel Tree project, every year
11 Captain White coordinated a Santa Boat ride into the *Merizo* Pier Park, presenting
12 Christmas gifts to the needy families of *Merizo* village; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Captain White also participated in numerous Homeland Security
14 Exercises; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Captain White partnered with local and federal law enforcement
16 agencies on the island to provide training opportunities; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Captain White developed a great working relationship with the
18 CNMI, the Freely Associated States/Federated States of Micronesia, and the outer-
19 lying islands; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Captain White’s legacy will be remembered by those in our
21 community with whom she has worked closely, either personally or professionally;
22 now therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
24 on behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate and commend Captain Casey J.
25 White for her service and her invaluable contributions to our community on Guam;
26 and be it further


27 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
