9 to Joaquin Manibusan); Johnny Roberto (married to Dolores Garrido); Michael
10 Roberto (married to Kate Connolly); Gloria Mae Roberto-Sasamoto (married to
11 Jerry); and Gary Roberto (married to Gera); and

12 **WHEREAS**, Joaquina is also blessed with twenty-one (21) grandchildren,
13 twenty-five (25) great grandchildren, and five (5) great-great grandchildren; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Joaquina graduated from the Territorial College of Guam, now
15 the University of Guam, and she received additional educational training at off-
16 island institutions; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Joaquina had devoted her life to working as a public servant,
18 serving as a Member of the Guam Congress from 1948 to 1950; and for forty-two
19 (42) years, she was employed with the Guam Department of Education, where she
20 served as a teacher and a school principal; and

21 **WHEREAS**, this exceptional centenarian and distinguished woman, with her
22 zest for life, who has experienced the incredible joys and sorrows characteristic of
23 and reserved for those with the stamina and courage to savor a full life, has
24 inspired and enhanced the lives of her many friends and family; and

25 **WHEREAS**, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to publicly recognize
26 Joaquina Mendiola Roberto for reaching such a remarkable age and witnessing and
27 celebrating the innovations, cultural developments and awesome achievements of
28 this country during the last century, while contributing to the growth and
29 excellence of our island; now therefore, be it


30 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*

40 *Guåhan*.




