1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Leonard “Len” P. Isotoff was born in Chuuk State, Federated
4 States of Micronesia; he graduated from Central High School in Independence,
5 Oregon, in 1989, and then attended Oregon State University, where he earned a
6 Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration, in 1994; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 1995, Mr. Isotoff worked with the Air Freight Division of
8 the National Fisheries Corporation, a public corporation established by the
9 Federated States of Micronesia government in Kolonia, Pohnpei; and in 1998, Len
10 was employed with Continental Air Micronesia in Kolonia, Pohnpei; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 1999, Mr. Isotoff served as a project manager for the Palau
12 Road Project for Matson Logistics Solutions, a subsidiary of Matson Navigation
13 Company; and a year later, Mr. Isotoff formally joined Matson Logistics as the
14 Manager for Logistics in Guam; and in 2000, Mr. Isotoff was promoted to the
15 position of Manager of Sales and Customer Service, Matson Navigation Company,
16 Guam and Micronesia; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Isotoff continued to climb the ladder in his maritime
18 career, receiving a promotion in 2003 and becoming the Manager of Sales for the
19 Pacific Northwest with Matson Navigation Company in Seattle, Washington; and
20 in 2006, Mr. Isotoff was once again promoted and served as the Manager of
21 Container Operations with Matson Navigation Company in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

22 **WHEREAS**, in 2008, Mr. Isotoff returned to Guam to take the helm as the
23 General Manager of Matson Navigation Company, Guam and Micronesia, where
24 he continued the positive and collaborative relationship between Matson and the
25 Port Authority of Guam, the islands of Micronesia, and the western Pacific region;
26 and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Isotoff’s professional career momentum continues as was
2 evident in his promotion this year to the position of the Director of Sales of the
3 Pacific Region for Matson Navigation Company in Hawai`i, where he will be
4 responsible for the day-to-day sales execution for Guam/Micronesia and the South
5 Pacific services; and

6 **WHEREAS**, throughout his tenure as General Manager of Matson, Mr.
7 Isotoff continued to strengthen relationships, providing invaluable assistance,
8 support and guidance to safeguard the sustained flow of goods and commodities
9 for island consumers, as illustrated by Matson being a co-investor in the
10 acquisition of three modern cranes for the Port Authority of Guam to ensure that its
11 operations meet current demands and future growth needs; and

12 **WHEREAS**, during Mr. Isotoff’s service as the General Manager of Matson
13 Navigation Company, Guam and Micronesia, his efforts reflected Matson’s
14 commitment to excellence in transpacific maritime services, providing a vital
15 economic lifeline to the islands of the Pacific from Hawaii to Guam and
16 Micronesia; and

17 **WHEREAS**, throughout his tenure as General Manager of Matson
18 Navigation Company, Guam and Micronesia, Mr. Isotoff also was instrumental in
19 continuing the efforts to improve the infrastructure and logistics of the Port
20 Authority of Guam to ensure consistent and reliable weekly ocean transportation
21 services to and from Guam, and throughout the Western Pacific; and

22 **WHEREAS**, in his professional and personal capacities, Mr. Isotoff has
23 heeded the call to assist the community and has served in civic associations,
24 paralleling Matson Navigation Company’s commitment to improve the
25 communities where its employees live by growing its corporate-citizen footprint
26 via donations, or taking active participation in community-improvement events,
27 such as the launch of the “*Adahi I Tano*’” Program, an environmental cleanup

1 initiative implemented in 2012, in collaboration with the Island-wide
2 Beautification Task Force of Guam, that encourages all non-profit organizations to
3 coordinate cleanup efforts to benefit the environment, while raising money for
4 charitable causes; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Isotoff also served for eight years as a member of the
6 Guam USO Advisory Council; and as a past president, he dedicated Matson's in-
7 kind and financial support to multiple events and USO center operations; and he
8 provided leadership and guidance to ensure that Guam's USO had the resources,
9 strategic planning and organizational health for the comfort, care and connectivity
10 of service members and their families; and

11 **WHEREAS**, some of Matson Navigation Company's other notable
12 contributions under the direction of Mr. Isotoff include the support given to the
13 Association of Pacific Island Legislatures (APIL), the Guam Public Library
14 System Bookmobile "Library on Wheels" program, the University of Guam's
15 Capital Campaign, and the University of Guam *Isla* Center for the Arts; now
16 therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
18 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
19 people of Guam, recognize, thank and commend Mr. Leonard "Len" P. Isotoff for
20 his countless contributions to Guam and Micronesia, and for being a stalwart
21 member of the community committed to the betterment of Guam and the islands of
22 the Micronesian region, and its people; and does further extend best wishes to Mr.
23 Isotoff, his wife, Fiona; and their children, Ikaika, Phylisia and Nua, as they
24 relocate to the State of Hawai`i; and be it further


25 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on

- 2 to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


