1           **WHEREAS**, in 1981, Mrs. Payne graduated from the Northwestern Visayan  
2 Colleges with a Bachelor of Science in Major Banking and Finance. She has also  
3 completed numerous courses in Business and Human Resources Management from  
4 the University of Maryland, Asian Division; and,

5           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Payne started her federal government service in 1992,  
6 working as an Accounting Technician with the Moral Welfare and Recreation Unit  
7 at Andersen Air Force Base, Guam; and,

8           **WHEREAS**, in 1994, Mrs. Payne then worked as a Payroll Clerk for the  
9 Department of the Air Force; and as Chief of the Civilian Pay Department at  
10 Andersen Air Force Base, until 1996; and,

11           **WHEREAS**, from 1997 to 2002, Ms. Annie Payne worked as the  
12 Accounting Liaison for the Department of the Air Force; and she then transferred  
13 to the 36<sup>th</sup> Comptroller Squadron to serve as a Financial Analyst; and,

14           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Payne continued her career in finances during the Joint  
15 Basing evolution in 2010 when she joined the Comptroller Division at Joint  
16 Region Marianas to work as a Financial Technician; and where she was employed  
17 until September 30, 2013; and,

18           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Payne has received numerous awards during her tenure  
19 with the federal government, to include: in 1995, she was selected as the  
20 Outstanding Employee of the Quarter at Andersen Air Force Base; in 2005 and  
21 2006, consecutively, she was selected as the Civilian Employee of the Year of the  
22 36<sup>th</sup> Air Expeditionary Wing and Comptroller Squadron; in 2007, she was the  
23 recipient of the Outstanding Employee of the Year Award at Andersen Air Force  
24 Base, Guam; and in 2008, Ms. Annie Payne was selected, amongst her peers from  
25 Alaska, Japan, Korea, Hawaii and Guam, as the Employee of the Quarter for the 4<sup>th</sup>  
26 Quarter; and,

27           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Annie Payne is an active member of the Lions Club  
28 International and the American Cancer Society; and she has held prestigious

1 positions in these civic organizations, from 1992 to the present. Her commitment


