2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, Ms. Janet A. Quitugua, fondly known as Jan, officially retires**
4 **from the Government of Guam on September 30, 2013, as a Planner III with the**
5 **Bureau of Statistics and Plans, after dedicating thirty-four (34) years of service to the**
6 **people of Guam; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua graduated from George Washington High School in
2 1979; and soon after, she worked for a brief time with the Department of Mental
3 Health and Substance Abuse under the Agency for Human Resources Development
4 program; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua began her government career at the Bureau of
6 Statistics and Plans in March 1981, working as a Planning Technician under the
7 Planning Information Program. In March 1984, she was promoted to Planner I, and
8 through her work excellence, she was elevated to Planner II in August 1986. Ms.
9 Quitugua remained at the Bureau, where she was finally promoted to Planner III in
10 June 1993, and she served well in that capacity until her retirement; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 2009, Ms. Quitugua was designated to serve as the Bureau of
12 Statistics and Plans' Equal Employment Opportunity Women's Program Coordinator,
13 addressing matters related to the advancement and equal opportunity for women; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua has dedicated her career to helping others with
15 critical data needs. Throughout her 34 years of government service, she was involved
16 in the analysis, research, and the delivery of key demographic, economic and social
17 data to our community for purposes of stimulating greater economic growth and
18 development; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua's outstanding achievements include her
20 contributions to the compilation, development and release of the "Guam Statistical
21 Yearbook" and the "Guam Facts and Figures - At a Glance" brochure. These
22 statistical products have been used widely by our government and business
23 community, serving as a valuable resource tool in enabling our government and civic
24 leaders to make informed decisions on where we are today, and how we can move
25 forward to improve the quality of life for the people of Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua was instrumental in the development of the “Guam
2 Inventory of Planning Information” and the “Planners’ Bookshelf,” where her vast
3 knowledge of Guam’s planning documents has assisted and benefitted many
4 government agencies and private businesses in obtaining access to master plans,
5 reports, surveys, and information sources available within government of Guam
6 agencies and the private sector; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua played a critical role in the planning and execution
8 of the 2010 Guam Census, serving as the Assistant Manager for Office Operations.
9 She was directly involved in the organization and set-up of the local Guam Census
10 Office. She was responsible for the coordination and supervision of all office
11 operations, including the supervision and training of office clerks, recruitment,
12 oversight of the entry of all housing and population records, and the processing of
13 thousands of census questionnaires, providing for a complete count of Guam’s
14 households; and

15 **WHEREAS**, as a long-time staff member of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans,
16 Ms. Quitugua is recognized for her outstanding work for the Bureau, and she will be
17 missed for her invaluable and institutional knowledge, and her contributions to the
18 island’s social, physical, economic and environmental development; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua will be genuinely missed and remembered by her
20 colleagues for her good-natured spirit, her friendliness, and remarkably, as the
21 employee with the “bright smile,” as she always shared a smile with everyone she
22 came in contact with; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Quitugua will now enjoy her retirement in the company and
24 love of her children, Crystal and Noli Pagarido, Michael, Marie, and Christopher, and
25 with her mother, Maria; and she is filled with excitement and joy as she settles into
26 her new home in *Toto*; and she will further enjoy her retirement participating with the


1 various activities she enjoys - gatherings with family and friends, baking, church
2 activities, and playing with Leo, the family pet; now therefore, be it
