2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Guam is currently home to thousands of individuals of Filipino
4 ancestry; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam continue to have a strong relationship with
2 the Filipino community on Guam built by years of friendship, kinship, and a shared
3 sentiment of wanting our island to prosper and flourish; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Filipinos have helped to enrich and diversify Guam by
5 establishing themselves as integral members of the island community. Many
6 individuals of Filipino ancestry diligently serve our island as educators, business
7 leaders, doctors, nurses, police officers, accountants, government officials, and in
8 many other professions; and

9 **WHEREAS**, dozens of organizations on Guam are led by various Filipino
10 groups, and the community contributions of these groups have proven to be invaluable
11 and beneficial to the overall success of Guam and its people; and

12 **WHEREAS**, one such Filipino-led group, the Bataan Association of Guam, is a
13 non-profit organization comprised of former residents of the historical province of
14 Bataan, and those considered originating from the province by way of blood, ancestry,
15 or affinity; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Bataan is considered one of the most progressive provinces in
17 Central Luzon and the Manila Bay region. Bataan is particularly significant because of
18 its location at the center of the Philippines' growth triad corridor of the Subic Bay
19 Metropolitan Authority (SBMA), the Clark Special Economic Zone, and Metro
20 Manila, and it is a strategic transport route and transshipment point linking the SBMA
21 area and other Central Luzon provinces to Metro Manila; and

22 **WHEREAS**, with all its business activity, Bataan continues to be a key
23 contributor to the overall economic growth of Central Luzon, and the country as a
24 whole; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Bataan Association of Guam seeks to carry out programs and
2 activities that promote and develop the cultural, artistic, and social interests of the
3 organization. Additionally, the Association pledges to undertake community-related
4 projects that benefit not only its members and other Filipino groups but the entire
5 island of Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Bataan Association of Guam recently elected its Officers,
7 Board of Directors, and Board of Trustees to serve until 2015; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the newly-elected Officers of the Bataan Association of Guam
9 include: Wilner A. Dizon, President; Angelina “Leng” Cruz, Vice President; Josie
10 Mercado, Secretary; Carmencita “Chita” Cortez, Assistant Secretary; Arsenia “Baby”
11 Sabinay, Treasurer; Dolor Dela Cruz, Assistant Treasurer; Letty Cunanan, Auditor;
12 Rey Malixi, Public Relations Officer; and Nolex Dising, Peace Officer. The newly-

14 Rizaldy Cortez; and Nixon Mercado. The newly-elected Board of Trustees includes:
15 Armando Dominguez; Manny Cunanan; Jay R Dominguez; and Arsenio Santiago;

3 *Guåhan*.


