3 **WHEREAS,** after moving to Guam with her family in late 2005, Nancy A.
4 Jones became the Director of Membership Services for the Guam Girl Scouts, Inc.,
5 bringing with her a professional background and experience in the Girl Scouts, after
6 having served on the U.S.A. Girl Scouts Overseas staff in Germany and Okinawa; and

1 **WHEREAS**, when Nancy A. Jones joined the Guam Girl Scouts staff in 2005,
2 its scout membership numbered at four hundred twenty-one (421); and with her
3 contributions, the membership has steadily grown surpassing one thousand (1,000)
4 girl scouts today; and

5 **WHEREAS**, during her tenure as the Director of Membership Services at the
6 Guam Girl Scouts, Nancy A. Jones oversaw the implementation of the “Service Unit”
7 structure, through which she provided support to teams of leaders serving in the local
8 villages, as well as at the Air Force and Naval bases; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Nancy A. Jones has helped new troops to form on Guam, and she
10 has spent many personal hours visiting troop meetings and offering training,
11 membership development skills, and, most significantly, creating a pilot program to
12 introduce Girl Scouting at the *Talofofa* Elementary School; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Nancy A. Jones holds a certification as a Girl Scout Master
14 Trainer, and she has mentored many local Guam residents to become certified Girl
15 Scout trainers; and

16 **WHEREAS**, throughout her tenure serving at the Guam Girl Scouts, Nancy A.
17 Jones has managed and facilitated vital programs, including, Train the Trainer, the
18 Camp Training, and the Program Aide Training, ensuring that the spirit of the Girl
19 Scouts remains alive and well in the Guam community, and in a sustainable
20 relationship with the environment; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Nancy A. Jones has assisted in the creation of opportunities for
22 mandated Service Learning hours; and while doing her noble work, she has been able
23 to raise Guam’s image in the national and global Girl Scouts community; now
24 therefore, be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Dos Na*
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people

1 of Guam, recognize and commend Nancy A. Jones for her outstanding and dedicated

10 J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


