1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA TRENTAI***
2 ***DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port (Port) was
4 established as a public corporation and autonomous government agency by the
5 enactment of Public Law 13-87 in October 1975; and

6 **WHEREAS,** over the last three (3) decades, the Port has developed into a
7 major transshipment center for the Western Pacific Region, providing full services to
8 ocean passenger, cargo and fishing vessels; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in Fiscal Year 2013, the Port processed more than one million
2 seven hundred thousand (1,700,000) revenue tons of cargo, providing vital goods to
3 the people of Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Port continues to support the neighboring islands of
5 Micronesia, by transshipping approximately thirty-five million (35,000,000) gallons
6 of fuel and three hundred ninety thousand (390,000) revenue tons of essential goods
7 throughout Micronesia; and

8 **WHEREAS**, three hundred thirty-four (334) Port employees operate and
9 maintain five (5) cargo handling piers, a container yard, two (2) marinas, a harbor of
10 refuge, and two (2) recreational beaches; and

11 **WHEREAS**, as part of the Guam Commercial Port Improvement Program, the
12 Port has since commenced Phase I of its Container Freight Station renovation project,
13 which is designed to provide office space for operations personnel, as well as covered
14 storage space for cargo, to be completed by January 2014; also, the Port will shortly
15 embark on Phase II of the demolition of Warehouse Two, and a break bulk yard
16 expansion, with a completion date of June 2014; and

17 **WHEREAS**, along with its other capital improvement projects, the Port, upon
18 having successfully completed Phase I of the Gregorio D. Perez Marina renovation
19 and site improvement, aggressively steered ahead with Phase II, which is scheduled
20 for completion this month; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Port has commenced the construction of a new centralized
22 emergency operations center to be completed by December 2013; and

23 **WHEREAS**, also notable is the enactment of Public Law 32-42, a critical
24 component to assisting the Port in securing the financial means to support the repair of
25 the F-5 Wharf; and


26 **WHEREAS**, the Employees, Management, and the Board of Directors of the
27 Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port continue to remain steadfastly committed to

1 taking on the challenges of modernizing the Port to meet the ever-changing needs of
2 the island's economic growth; now therefore, be it


3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
5 of Guam, congratulate and commend the dedicated Employees, Management and
6 Board of Directors of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port on the occasion of
7 its Thirty-Eighth (38th) Year Anniversary, and on the observance of "Port Week,"
8 from October 21 to October 25, 2013; and does further encourage the people of Guam
9 to actively participate in the activities related to the celebration of the Port's Thirty-
