3 WHEREAS, the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port (Port) was 4 established as a public corporation and autonomous government agency by the 5 enactment of Public Law 13-87 in October 1975; and

6 WHEREAS, over the last three (3) decades, the Port has developed into a 7 major transshipment center for the Western Pacific Region, providing full services to 8 ocean passenger, cargo and fishing vessels; and 1 WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2013, the Port processed more than one million 2 seven hundred thousand (1,700,000) revenue tons of cargo, providing vital goods to 3 the people of Guam; and

4 WHEREAS, the Port continues to support the neighboring islands of 5 Micronesia, by transshipping approximately thirty-five million (35,000,000) gallons 6 of fuel and three hundred ninety thousand (390,000) revenue tons of essential goods 7 throughout Micronesia; and

8 WHEREAS, three hundred thirty-four (334) Port employees operate and 9 maintain five (5) cargo handling piers, a container yard, two (2) marinas, a harbor of 10 refuge, and two (2) recreational beaches; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Guam Commercial Port Improvement Program, the Port has since commenced Phase I of its Container Freight Station renovation project, which is designed to provide office space for operations personnel, as well as covered storage space for cargo, to be completed by January 2014; also, the Port will shortly embark on Phase II of the demolition of Warehouse Two, and a break bulk yard expansion, with a completion date of June 2014; and

WHEREAS, along with its other capital improvement projects, the Port, upon
having successfully completed Phase I of the Gregorio D. Perez Marina renovation
and site improvement, aggressively steered ahead with Phase II, which is scheduled
for completion this month; and

WHEREAS, the Port has commenced the construction of a new centralized
emergency operations center to be completed by December 2013; and

WHEREAS, also notable is the enactment of Public Law 32-42, a critical component to assisting the Port in securing the financial means to support the repair of the F-5 Wharf; and

WHEREAS, the Employees, Management, and the Board of Directors of the
 Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port continue to remain steadfastly committed to

taking on the challenges of modernizing the Port to meet the ever-changing needs ofthe island's economic growth; now therefore, be it
