3        **WHEREAS, Jon A. Anderson has long been a familiar media personality to the**  
4        **residents of Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI);**  
5        **and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Jon A. Anderson is a founding partner of the Sorensen Media  
2 Group (SMG), which was formed in 1980 as K-57 Radio, Inc.; and

3           **WHEREAS**, to many radio listeners on Guam, Jon A. Anderson will fondly be  
4 remembered as the person who ushered in the concept of talk radio, serving as the host  
5 of the popular K-57 “Breakfast Show” for twenty years. His morning radio program  
6 allowed listeners to call in and discuss various topics of interest within our  
7 community; and

8           **WHEREAS**, during his time at SMG, Jon A. Anderson also served as the  
9 General Manager, and as a corporate executive, as the company expanded its  
10 operations into the CNMI. Additionally, Jon anchored the first television news  
11 broadcast of the Pacific News Center, the news program formed under SMG; and

12           **WHEREAS**, after leaving Sorensen Media Group, Jon A. Anderson became a  
13 Loan Officer for Bridge Capital, LLC, in December 2006, and he was assigned to  
14 work in Saipan. He was reassigned to Guam in April 2006 to work as a Senior Asset  
15 Executive, and served in that capacity until June 2010; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Jon A. Anderson made his foray back into the field of journalism  
17 when he was named as the Editor-in-Chief of the Marianas Variety Guam Edition, in  
18 December 2010, expanding his resume to include print media; and

19           **WHEREAS**, after serving for approximately three years in this position with  
20 the Marianas Variety Guam Edition, Jon A. Anderson began his retirement on  
21 December 14, 2013; and

22           **WHEREAS**, Jon A. Anderson leaves behind a long journalism career in which  
23 he had covered many significant events on Guam and the CNMI, including super  
24 typhoons, elections, and island visits from world dignitaries; and helped solidify his  
25 reputation as one of our region’s premiere broadcast journalists; and


1           **WHEREAS**, the work of Jon A. Anderson has been a tremendous public
