3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Mateo Paet is the loving husband of Mrs. Carmelia Paet; and
4 they reside in the village of *Yoña* with their grandchildren; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in June 1977, Mr. Paet graduated from the Guam Vocational and
6 Technical High School in *Mangilao*; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Paet served as a member of the United States Army from
2 February 1969 to September 1972, serving for three (3) years and seven (7) months;
3 and

4 **WHEREAS**, from January 1973 to September 1992, Mr. Paet was employed
5 with Guam Cable Television; and he then was employed with Island Wireless Cable,
6 from March 1993 to February 1994; and

7 **WHEREAS**, following his more than twenty (20) years of work experience
8 with the cable television industry, Mr. Paet was employed by San Nicolas Security,
9 from June 1994 to December 1995; and

10 **WHEREAS**, on January 31, 1996, Mr. Paet began his government of Guam
11 career with the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA), serving as an
12 Environmental Aide, an Environmental Inspector I, and as an Environmental Inspector
13 II, his current position; and

14 **WHEREAS**, holding the position of Environmental Inspector II under the
15 Water Pollution Control Program, Mr. Paet helped to regulate and enforce local laws,
16 including the Water Pollution Control Act, and the Toilet Facilities and Sewage
17 Disposal Act; and he also administered several smaller programs that play an essential
18 role in protecting public health, such as the protection of the primary source of
19 Guam's drinking water, the Northern Aquifer, and Guam's waters from point and non-
20 point sources of water pollution; and

21 **WHEREAS**, after eighteen (18) years of service with the Government of
22 Guam, Mr. Mateo Paet will retire on Friday, January 3, 2014, as an Environmental
23 Inspector II of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA); now therefore,
24 be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people


1 of Guam, commend and congratulate Mr. Mateo Paet on the occasion of his retirement
