1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, Mrs. Alicia R. Hipolito was born on June 26, 1944, in Manila,**
4 **Philippines; and she graduated from the University of the EAST in Manila, in April 1964.**
5 **In October 1976, Mrs. Hipolito moved to Guam when her husband, Nestor, was hired by**
6 **the Federal Aviation Administration to work on Guam. Together, Alicia and Nestor have**

1 three (3) children: Peter, Edgar and Eleanor; and they reside in the village of *Barrigada*;
2 and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Hipolito began her federal civil service career in March 1980
4 with the United States Navy Public Works Center (PWC) Guam, where she served as a
5 Systems Accountant in the Comptroller Department at the level of a GS 510-05 to GS
6 510-09 employee; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in March 1984, Mrs. Hipolito was promoted to the position of
8 Systems Accountant GS 510-11; and in January 1990, she was again promoted to the
9 position of Supervisory Accountant GS 510-12. In 1992, as a result of the Deployment
10 Requirements Manning Document (DRMD) capitalization, transferring all accounting
11 functions to the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS), Mrs. Hipolito became
12 the DFAS Director for DFAS Operating Location, Guam, managing the entire payroll,
13 vendor payments, general ledger, and funding resources for the United States Department
14 of the Navy in Guam; and

15 **WHEREAS**, as Director for the Guam area, Mrs. Hipolito was responsible for
16 numerous accounting functions in such areas as the Ship Repair Facility (SRF); the Fleet
17 and Industrial Supply Center (FISC); the Naval Magazine Guam (NAVMAG); the
18 Commander Naval Forces Marianas (COMNAVMAR); the Naval Air Station, *Agaña*
19 (NAS); the Naval Communications Station (NCS); and the U.S. Navy Public Works
20 Center (PWC), Guam; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the enormous leadership challenges faced by Mrs. Hipolito during
22 this era of rapid growth and change was recognized by her superiors, and she was
23 awarded the prestigious "Directors Award" from DFAS Cleveland in 1995; and

24 **WHEREAS**, in 1996, DFAS Guam centralized its functions in Hawaii and
25 Oakland, and Mrs. Hipolito returned to serve at the U.S. Navy Public Works Center,
26 Guam as a Supervisory Accountant GS 510-12; and

27 **WHEREAS**, in August 2007, Mrs. Hipolito was promoted to the position of

1 Accounting Officer GS 510-13, and she worked as the Director of the General and Cost
2 Accounting Division in the Comptroller Department; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Hipolito has been an active member and officer of the
4 American Society of the Military Comptrollers (ASMC), Guam Chapter, and she became
5 President of the Chapter for several years during the Honorable Robert Hale's (USD(C)
6 directorship; and her service had been recognized for this great effort by the Air Force
7 General Auditor at an Andersen Air Force Base ASMC luncheon in 1988; and

8 **WHEREAS**, throughout Mrs. Hipolito's civil service career, she received
9 numerous awards and accolades attesting to her professionalism, dedication, superior
10 performance, and can-do attitude; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Hipolito identified inefficiencies in workload processes, and
12 she began automating manual processes by utilizing personal computer applications,
13 which included, the computerization of the manual General Ledger; the systemization of
14 Navy Accounts Payable; the development of streamlined processes for timely processing
15 of a significant volume of credit card invoices; comprehensive and informative forms for
16 customers to accommodate their questions and needs; the creation of consolidated
17 treasury data (formerly CERPS, now labeled as CHOOSE) to identify cost and
18 collections and create a register for timely recording to financial records; and the
19 implementation of the use of work orders in SLDCADA for technical fees for automatic
20 billing to customers' funding; and

21 **WHEREAS**, when she was challenged to resolve problems with no clear existing
22 precedents, Mrs. Hipolito's remarkable resourcefulness helped her to overcome the final
23 challenge in order to support her management of the DWAS accounting system,
24 generating reliable financial data with DONIBIS (Department of the Navy Industrial
25 Budget Information System) for NAVFAC Marianas, and closely monitoring funding and
26 billing of customers to ensure the proper support of the commodity managers' efforts,
27 both for Navy and 36 CES; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Hipolito maintained the status of zero unbillable accounts
2 receivables, no overage accounts receivables, and no overage unmatched disbursements
3 for NAVFAC Marianas NWCF; and her attention to detail earned her a “Bravo Zulu”
4 rating from Inspector General (IG) reports, and recognition from NAVFAC
5 Headquarters; now therefore, be it


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan*
