- 3 WHEREAS, Assistant United States Attorney Karon Johnson began working
- 4 for the U.S. Attorney's Office in April, 1989; and

1	WHEREAS, since then, U.S. Attorney Karon Johnson has prosecuted					
2	thousands of criminal cases, including immigration fraud, drug trafficking, the sale of					
3	counterfeit merchandise, official corruption, wire fraud, mail fraud, and environmental					
4	crimes; and					
5	WHEREAS, with the help of NOAA special agent Chuck Raterman, U.S.					
6	Attorney Johnson established the first permanent reward program for people who turn					
7	in turtle poachers; and					
8	WHEREAS, in November 1989, Karon began pursuing a non-work related					
9	activity, joining with Marie Chenery, Rebecca Tomzik, and others, to form an					
10	organization for abused/abandoned animals, calling it Guam Animals In Need					
11	(GAIN); and					
12	WHEREAS, during the early years of GAIN, Karon and Marie Chenery					
13	literally held the organization together, protecting and saving animals that would					
14	otherwise have suffered, and some could have died; and					
15	WHEREAS, in August 1990, Karon drafted an agreement between GAIN and					
16	the Department of Public Health and Social Services to allow GAIN to provide animal					
17	care, supplies and food at the government-run animal shelter; and					
18	WHEREAS, in November 1993, in further caring for stray animals at GAIN,					
19	Karon donated a cat enclosure to the shelter; and during the winter of 2000, Karon					
20	obtained an \$8,000 grant from the Gannett Foundation for Versa cages for cats; and					
21	WHEREAS, on March 19, 2001, Karon and her spouse, Rob Kautz, worked					
22	with then-Governor of Guam Carl T.C. Gutierrez on a Memorandum of					
23	Understanding (MOU) for GAIN to take responsibility of the animal shelter; and					
24	WHEREAS, on June 3, 2002, GAIN paid One Dollar (\$1) for a 30-year lease					
25	of the animal shelter, after Governor Gutierrez signed the lease agreement; and					
26	WHEREAS, on April 8, 2005, legislation drafted by Karon and Guam					

legislators became Bill No. 56 (EC), to prevent animal suffering; and

1	WHEREAS, from February to April 30, 2005, Karon worked tirelessly with
2	local contractors and businesses so that a typhoon-proof cat facility could be built; and
3	WHEREAS, on April 30, 2005, Father Patrick Castro blessed the Karon V.
4	Johnson Cat Facility, with Karon's efforts giving the cats and kittens a safe home; and
5	WHEREAS, from 2000 to 2007, Karon assisted the membership chairperson of
6	GAIN to increase its membership from one hundred (100) to nearly five hundred
7	(500) members; and
8	WHEREAS, from 2008 to 2009, Karon once again worked with contractors
9	and businesses so that GAIN's fragile puppy kennels could be typhoon-proofed; and
10	WHEREAS, in 2010, Karon worked with GAIN members and Senator Judith
11	P. Guthertz, DPA, to get Macon's Law passed and signed; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2010 after the Guam Greyhound Rescue team rescued more
13	than two hundred (200) greyhounds and shipped them off island, Karon worked with
14	members and Senator V. Anthony Ada to get the ban on dog racing bill passed and
15	signed into law; and
16	WHEREAS, Karon was always the "go to" person when the shelter needed
17	supplies and equipment. She would spend nearly Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000)
18	yearly to make certain the animals were given whatever was needed to keep them
19	happy and healthy; and
20	WHEREAS, in 2012, Karon and Rob donated over \$5,000 to Fur-Ever Kinda
21	Love to provide necessary Project Pet Care funds for responsible pet care to island pet
22	owners, with pets being given free rabies vaccinations and wormers, and having their
23	nails trimmed, their ears cleaned, and their teeth checked; and
24	WHEREAS, from 2012 to 2013, Karon participated in the village to village
25	Project Pet Care health clinics and distributed information and discounted spay and
26	neuter coupons; and

1 WHEREAS, in September 2013, Karon and her spouse, Rob, sponsored the 2 Fur-Ever's first calendar, that was printed and sold to raise funds for future clinics, 3 and their dedication to loving and assisting animals in need has always been at the top 4 of their agendas; now therefore, be it 5 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Dos Na 6 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 7 of Guam, commend and recognize Assistant United States Attorney Karon Johnson 8 for her dedication and hard work with the GAIN Animal Shelter to protect and save 9 many animals that would otherwise have needlessly perished, and for her generosity 10 and love of domesticated animals and of our community; and be it further 11 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 12 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of 13 the same be thereafter transmitted to Assistant United States Attorney Karon Johnson; 14 and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, I Maga'lahen Guåhan.
