1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** George Maddock was born on January 22, 1937, growing up
4 and learning life's first lessons in Long Island, New York, through the guidance
5 from his loving parents, Clinton Maddock and Grace Dunn Maddock. Upon his

1 high school graduation from Glenclyffe High School in June 1955, he entered and
2 invested in the Capuchin Order on August 31, 1955. Through God's grace, his life
3 took a wonderful turn as he continued on in his spiritual journey with the Lord; and

4 **WHEREAS**, through his great gratitude for the blessings in his life, he
5 made his Solemn Perpetual profession on September 1, 1959; and four years later,
6 he was ordained into the Priesthood on January 11, 1964; and

7 **WHEREAS**, in Wassaic, New York, Father George served as the Pastor of
8 St. Michael's Church, strengthening the Catholic faith in the community. He
9 expressed his direct obedience to the Lord when he went to Estelí, Nicaragua, to
10 fulfill his missionary work. Father George radiated his love for the Lord Jesus
11 Christ through his service to the people of Nicaragua; and in 1965, he came to our
12 beautiful island of Guam; and

13 **WHEREAS**, through his consistent obedience to the Lord, Father George
14 was blessed to inspire young professionals through his years of teaching at Father
15 Dueñas Memorial School. His generous service and commitment to the School
16 would lead him to become the Principal, and the Seminary Director of Father
17 Dueñas Memorial School; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Lord created Father George to be a born spiritual leader of
19 our island through his given position as a Superior Regular of the Capuchins,
20 serving from 1970 to 1976. His spiritual services extended throughout the island of
21 Guam when he was assigned to be the Pastor of Saint Francis Catholic Church in
22 *Yona*, where he served from 1975 to 1984; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Lord blessed Father George's walk in faith and led him to
24 another tropical paradise, where he established the Capuchin presence in Ewa,
25 Hawaii, becoming the Pastor of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church
26 Parish in 1984. Nine years later, Father George was assigned to serve as the Pastor
27 of Saint Elizabeth Catholic Parish in Aiea, Hawaii, in 1993; and

1 **WHEREAS**, since 2007, Father George has resided at the St. Fidelis Friary
2 in *Agaña Heights*, Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Father George Maddock has devoted his life to serving the
4 Lord Jesus Christ through his fifty (50) years of service to the faithful in Nicaragua
5 and the beautiful Mariana and Hawaiian Islands. His ministry has truly been
6 significant in strengthening and shaping the Catholic faith in the island
7 communities; now therefore, be it


8 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
10 people of Guam, commend and congratulate Reverend Father George Maddock,
11 O.F.M. Cap., on the occasion of his Golden (50th) Jubilee as a Priest of the Order
12 of Franciscan Minors Capuchin; and does further extend a warm *Un Dângkolo Na*
13 *Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to him for his dedicated spiritual service to the island
14 community; and be it further

15 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
16 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that

18 O.F.M. Cap.; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


