3 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid Perez, RSM, was born on June 14, 1939, in the
4 capitol village of *Hagatña*; and she is the third child of the eleven children of the late
5 Francisco and Juana Perez. She has lived a life of humility, honesty, and sacrifice
6 since answering the call to Sisterhood fifty-nine (59) years ago; and

1 **WHEREAS**, throughout those years, Sister Brigid has built many futures as
2 she has taught thousands of students while serving as a teacher at St. Anthony School,
3 Bishop Baumgartner Memorial School, Cathedral Grade School, Infant of Prague,
4 Mercy Heights Nursery and Kindergarten, and Santa Barbara School; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid’s respectful and loving teaching strategies ensured
6 that all her students were welcomed, respected, encouraged, and expected to realize
7 their potential; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid has strengthened families across the region as she
9 served on missions in the CNMI for ten (10) years, working for the Diocese of Chalan
10 Kanoa in Saipan, Tinian and Rota; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid then served a distinct set of families when she
12 became the Program Manager of *Alee* Shelter; and

13 **WHEREAS**, during the last ten (10) years, Sister Brigid has calmed fears,
14 provided safety nets, and helped to stop physical, social and emotional abuse through
15 her hard work at *Alee* Shelter; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid has provided community leadership as a member of
17 the Family Violence and Sexual Assault Task Force, the Coalition for Family
18 Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault, the Make-A-Wish Foundation of the CNMI,
19 the National Center on Elder Abuse, and the *Rigalu* Foundation; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid received the 2011 *Hustisia* Award for making an
21 outstanding contribution to strengthening and improving the administration of justice
22 throughout the island; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Sister Brigid Perez continues to seek community solutions to the
24 island's family violence and child abuse issues; now therefore, be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people

1 of Guam, honor, commend and thank Sister Brigid Perez, RSM, for strengthening the
2 lives of many families through her caring, determined, and dedicated life-long service
3 of teaching, caring, and leadership to the people of Guam and the region; and be it
4 further


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


