1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS, Mr. Perry C. Taitano has been a driving force behind the ongoing**  
4        **improvements made at the Judiciary of Guam for over 28 years. With the support of**  
5        **his wife, Lourdes Taitano, and their four children - Tia, Perry, Kawai and Adam, Mr.**

1 Taitano has been able to transcend his commitment as a family man into his  
2 professional life that has allowed him to be successful in his career at the Judiciary of  
3 Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano's educational background can attest to his expertise as  
5 a professional for the Judiciary of Guam. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Business  
6 Administration from California State University, Northridge, which he obtained in  
7 1975. Seeing the need to further advance his knowledge, he graduated from the  
8 University of Guam on May 16, 1980, with a Master's degree in Business  
9 Administration. He also became a Fellow of the Institute for Court Management in  
10 June of 1983, which is a prestigious organization known for contributing to the  
11 growing literature of court administration; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Perry's tenacity to succeed in all that he partakes in availed him of  
13 the opportunity to serve as the Chief of Administration for the Judiciary of Guam,  
14 from October 2, 1980 to May 2, 1981. His progressive career led him to become the  
15 Deputy Administrative Director of the Court, where he served from May 3, 1981 to  
16 September 27, 1987. Mr. Taitano's arduous work ethic and commitment led him to  
17 serve as an Administrative Director for the Superior Court of Guam, on September 28,  
18 1987; and he successfully held this position until his retirement on September 30,  
19 1994; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano's retirement from the Judiciary led him to further  
21 apply his expertise, as he became the Director of Business Development,  
22 Governmental Affairs for Straub Development Corporation, based on Guam, where he  
23 worked from November 1994 to April 1997. He was responsible for initiating and  
24 overseeing the planning, design and development of the northern, central, and

1 southern multispecialty clinics on Guam. He also worked closely with various  
2 government of Guam agencies to ensure that financial matters are maintained and  
3 carried out successfully to ensure a healthy business relationship; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano further expanded his career, and he became the Chief  
5 Operations Officer for the Doctor's Clinic on Guam, serving from August 1998 to  
6 December 2003. He was responsible for service agreements and contracts to help  
7 render quality healthcare services for our island community; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano reignited his judicial career, and he was appointed by  
9 the Judicial Council of Guam to serve as Administrator of the Courts for the Judiciary  
10 on January 26, 2004. In this capacity, he was able to successfully oversee all  
11 personnel matters, as well as administrative duties for the court; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano was instrumental in supporting the strategic plans of  
13 Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido that has improved court management and services  
14 for its employees and the people of Guam. With limited funding for the Judiciary, Mr.  
15 Taitano and his colleagues were able to create a Budget Reduction Plan that helped  
16 cut costs where it could be spared. In addition to this plan, the court was able to avert  
17 the possibility of furloughs as the court was able to spend allotments provided by the  
18 government cautiously; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano's abilities to serve as a leader is not limited to just his  
20 work. He has served as a volunteer member for the Community First Federal Credit  
21 Union's predecessor, in the capacity of Supervisory Committee Chairman for a year;  
22 and subsequently served as Vice Chairman and Board Member for 14 years, with the  
23 added volunteer assignments of Committee Chairman for the Facilities, Strategic  
24 Planning and Technology Committee; and


1       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Taitano is currently involved with spearheading a transition  
2 team for a special project at the *Agaña Heights* Baptist Church, where he also  
3 volunteers his time as a Treasurer; and


4       **WHEREAS**, his dedication to the Judiciary of Guam and as a contributing
