3 **WHEREAS,** it is the custom of the Guam Legislature to recognize the
4 critically economic, cultural, social, and other notable contributions that members
5 of our community have made in countless ways toward the development of Guam;
6 and

1 **WHEREAS**, the mission of public radio is to create a more informed public
2 - one that is challenged and invigorated by a deeper understanding and
3 appreciation of events, ideas, and cultures; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the programming and content created and distributed by
5 public radio are based upon three core values: qualities of mind, qualities of heart
6 and qualities of craft; and exemplify the inherent meaning of localism by placing
7 value and financial investment in local and regional assets to gather and distribute
8 a collection of programming that informs and improves the community; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Public Broadcasting Act calls on the Corporation for
10 Public Broadcasting to encourage public telecommunications services that are
11 responsive to the interests of people in particular localities, to address the needs of
12 the underserved, and to ensure that all citizens of the United States have access to
13 public telecommunications services; and

14 **WHEREAS**, rising to this call, the Guam Educational Radio Foundation
15 (KPRG-FM 89.3) has provided this invaluable community service to the people of
16 Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands for twenty (20)
17 years; and

18 **WHEREAS**, shaped by geography, history and cultural diversity distinct
19 from the continental United States, the residents of Guam and the Commonwealth
20 of the Northern Mariana Islands represent a unique audience; and

21 **WHEREAS**, stressing the importance of public service broadcasting for
22 democratic societies and recognizing, therefore, the need to guarantee its
23 permanence and stability so as to allow it to continue to operate in the service of
24 the public, the Guam Legislature is extremely grateful to the Guam Educational
25 Radio Foundation (KPRG-FM 89.3) for helping the community to share in public
26 broadcasting's ability to inform, educate and inspire; and

1 **WHEREAS**, attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-
2 standing traditions, the Guam Legislature is justly proud to work in partnership
3 with the Guam Educational Radio Foundation (KPRG-FM 89.3), and looks
4 forward to building on that partnership in the future; now therefore, be it
