2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, a group of about sixteen (16) members of the *Zenkoku Gokoku*
4 *Jinjya Kai* from Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and to
5 offer prayers for those who died during World War II; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the *Zenkoku Gokoku Jinjya Kai* members visited World War II
7 sites on Guam, including the War in the Pacific National Historical Park overlook

1 on Nimitz Hill, and the *Mannengon* Memorial Site in the village of *Yona*, in order
2 to pay tribute and give prayers for those who died at these and other related sites
3 on Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, this visit and show of respect by the *Zenkoku Gokoku Jinjya*
5 *Kai* members from Japan is primarily to call on sites where World War II battles
6 were fought; and

7 **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this will become an annual trip, and that the
8 tribute made by the *Zenkoku Gokoku Jinjya Kai* members shines as an example
9 that will encourage other members and organizations from Japan to make similar
10 trips; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., and Mr. Ken Haga, have been
12 instrumental in the efforts to heal the wounds of World War II, and the tensions
13 created as a result of the war, between the people of Japan, Guam, and the United
14 States, and have held ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim
15 in mind; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the U. S. Explore & Study, Inc., along with its President, Mr.
17 Ken Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals, and
18 especially to help organize this trip by the members of the *Zenkoku Gokoku Jinjya*
19 *Kai* from Japan; now therefore, be it


20 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
